


New to QR Codes? Give it a try!

Portrait of an Ambassador: The Call of Peter

Scripture: Genesis 12:1-2, Matthew 4:18-22, John 1:35-42

Study Questions

Foundation 1: The call breaks ties and brings together

What kind of ties did Peter have to release to follow Jesus? Why do you think he would make those choices?

Foundation 2: The call is to follow and learn

There is a hodgepodge of Gentile and Jewish names here... Simon and Nathanael are Jewish, Philip and Andrew are Greek. What kind of world do you think they inhabited where a parent would give brothers names from different and rival ethnic groups?

Foundation 3: The call changes whom we work for

At the beginning of the story of Peter we don't yet know where he's going to end up, though we know he's going to be stable ("the rock"/Petros). Jesus knew and had a plan... but Peter had a lot to learn along the way. Do you see this connecting with other parts of the story of the whole Bible?

Implications: Ambassadors are Fishers of People

What does it mean to be fishers of people? While the Sunday School answer might be "win souls for Jesus"... we saw that for Peter it meant dropping his nets and leaving the family business behind. It also means he's not just refining Judaism, but going to reach the Gentiles.

Applications: Jesus Calls Us Where We Are

Do you think God called Peter as an institutional leader, or as the person who would continue growing a movement? What is God's call to Christians today?

Prayer

Let us pray that we hear God's call to us with clarity, unclouded by fear, by previous lack of success, or by challenges in the future. Let us pray also that God raises up helpers to equip us and for others for us to equip for his call.
