
New to QR Codes? Give it a try!

PORTRAITS OF AMBASSADORS

“Peter: A Divine Encounter ” Acts 3:1-10

STUDY QUESTIONS

Foundation (What?):

1. What do we learn about the man sitting at the Beautiful Gate?
3. Why do you think the man expected money from Peter and John? What stands out to you about Peter’s words: “Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you”?
6. How did the people respond when they saw the healed man walking and praising God?

Implication (So what?):

1. Why is it significant that the healing happened “in the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth”? What does this miracle reveal about the continuing work of Jesus through the apostles?
4. What does Peter’s willingness to stop and engage the man teach us about compassion and ministry?

Application (Now What?):

1. Are there people around you whom you tend to overlook because you see them so often? What does this passage teach us about seeing people with dignity rather than as interruptions?
3. Peter admitted what he did not have, but offered what he did have. What gifts or spiritual resources has God given you to share with others?
5. Is there an area where you are asking God merely for “silver and gold” while He may desire to bring deeper transformation? How might your daily routines, conversations, interruptions, or encounters become opportunities for God’s power and compassion to work through you?

CHALLENGE

Intentionally pause this week to notice someone you would normally hurry past. Ask God to show you how to offer encouragement, kindness, prayer, or practical help in Jesus’ name.

PRAYER FOCUS

- Pray for eyes to truly see people in need.
- Pray for courage to act in the name of Christ.
- Pray for healing — physical, emotional, and spiritual.
- Pray that Grace of Christ would be known for compassion, generosity, and joyful worship.
