Faith Building		
1.	In Christ, we are called to love	
	(John 13:34) A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another.	
2.	In Christ, we are called to obey	
	(John 14:15) If you love Me, you will keep My commandments.	
3.	In Christ, we are called to live	
	(Matthew 23:11-12) But the greatest of you shall be your servant. Whoever exalts himself shall be humbled, and whoever humbles himself shall be exalted.	
4.	In Christ, we are called to forgive	
	(Matthew 6:14-15) For if you forgive other people for their offenses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive other people, then your Father will not forgive your offenses.	
5.	In Christ, we are called to trust	
	(Matthew 6:31-33) Do not worry then, saying, 'What are we to eat?' or 'What are we to drink?' or 'What are we to wear for clothing?' For the Gentiles eagerly seek all these things; for your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be provided to you.	
6.	In Christ, we are called to sacrifice	
	(Luke 9:23-24) And He was saying to them all, "If anyone wants to come after Me, he must deny himself, take up his cross daily, and follow Me. For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake, this is the one who will save it.	
7.	In Christ, we are called to go	
	(Matthew 10:37-39) The one who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me; and the one who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me. And the one who does not take his cross and	

follow after Me is not worthy of Me. The one who has found his life will lose it, and the one who has lost his life on My account will find it.
