

(1:1-5) Paul, an apostle (not sent from men nor through human agency, but through Jesus Christ and God the Father, who raised Him from the dead), and all the brothers who are with me, To the churches of Galatia: Grace to you and peace from God the Father and our Lord Jesus Christ, who gave Himself for our sins so that He might rescue us from this present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father, to whom be the glory forevermore. Amen.

(v.6-7) I am amazed that you are so quickly deserting Him who called you by the grace of Christ, for a different gospel, which is not just another account; but there are some who are disturbing you and want to distort the gospel of Christ.

(v.8-9) But even if we, or an angel from heaven, should preach to you a gospel contrary to what we have preached to you, he is to be accursed! As we have said before, even now I say again: if anyone is preaching to you a gospel contrary to what you received, he is to be accursed!

1. \_\_\_\_\_ = I obey, therefore I'm accepted.

(2:16) a person is not justified by works of the Law but through faith in Christ Jesus,

- Those that walk according to legalism, try to \_\_\_\_\_ God's \_\_\_\_\_.

2. \_\_\_\_\_ = I'm accepted, so I don't need to obey.

(5:13) For you were called to freedom, brothers and sisters; only do not turn your freedom into an opportunity for the flesh,

- Those that walk according to license, \_\_\_\_\_ God's \_\_\_\_\_.

3. \_\_\_\_\_ = I'm accepted by grace through faith.

(2:20-21) I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me. I do not nullify the grace of God, for if righteousness comes through the Law, then Christ died needlessly.

- Those that walk according to grace, desire to \_\_\_\_\_ in obedience through the power of the \_\_\_\_\_.

We believe and confess that the gospel is the good news of what God has done in Christ to save sinners, not based on human merit or obedience to the law, but entirely by grace through faith. This gospel centers on the person and work of Jesus Christ and is applied to believers by the Holy Spirit. It includes the following essential truths:

1. Christ's \_\_\_\_\_ in life.

(4:4-5) God sent His Son, born of a woman, born under the Law, so that He might redeem those who were under the Law, that we might receive the adoption as sons and daughters.

(Isaiah 42:1-4)

2. Christ's \_\_\_\_\_ in death.

(3:13) Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law, having become a curse for us—for it is written: "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"

(Isaiah 53:3-6) (Psalm 22:16-18)

3. Christ's \_\_\_\_\_ in resurrection.

(1:1) Jesus Christ and God the Father, who raised Him from the dead (Psalm 16:10) (Hosea 6:2)

4. Christ's \_\_\_\_\_ to the Father.

(4:6-7) Because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying out, "Abba! Father!"

(Psalm 110:1) (Daniel 7:13-14)

5. Christ's \_\_\_\_\_ by the Spirit.

(3:2) This is the only thing I want to find out from you: did you receive the Spirit by works of the Law, or by hearing with faith?

(5:16) But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh.

(Ezekiel 36:26-27)
