2. Why do you think Paul uses the image of being "unequally yoked"? What happens when we try to mix the world's values with God's ways?

Read 2 Corinthians 7:8-10 out loud as a group.

3. How does grace actually lead us to repentance instead of giving us an excuse to stay the same?

Read 2 Corinthians 8:1-12 out loud as a group.

- 5. Why do you think Paul calls generosity "an act of grace"?

Read 2 Corinthians 9:5-15 out loud as a group.

- 6. What's the difference between giving out of guilt and giving out of grace?

- 8. How have you personally experienced God's grace shaping your heart toward generosity, repentance, or holiness lately?
