Prayer

Take time before discussion to take prayer requests and pray for each member of the group that requests prayer.

Read 2 Corinthians 6:1 out loud as a group.

1. What do you think Paul means by “receiving the grace of God in vain”?

Read 2 Corinthians 6:14-16 out loud as a group.

2. Why do you think Paul uses the image of being “unequally yoked”? What happens when we try to mix the world’s values with God’s ways?

Read 2 Corinthians 7:8-10 out loud as a group.

3. How does grace actually lead us to repentance instead of giving us an excuse to stay the same?

Read 2 Corinthians 8:1-12 out loud as a group.

4. What stands out to you about the Macedonians’ response to grace?
5. Why do you think Paul calls generosity “an act of grace”?

Read 2 Corinthians 9:5-15 out loud as a group.

6. What’s the difference between giving out of guilt and giving out of grace?
7. How does generosity help others see the grace of God?
8. How have you personally experienced God’s grace shaping your heart toward generosity, repentance, or holiness lately?
