Prayer

Take time before discussion to take prayer requests and pray for each member of the group that requests prayer.

Read Galatians 5:25-26 out loud as a group.

- 1. What does Paul mean by encouraging us to "live by the Spirit" and to "follow the Spirit as well"?
- 2. In what ways do we become boastful and say "look at me" instead of "look at Christ"?
- 3. How do we often reflect spiritual superiority to others? What about spiritual inferiority?

Read Galatians 6:1-10 out loud as a group.

- 4. What does it look like to lovingly correct a brother or sister? What is the difference between just calling them out and restoring them?
- 5. How do "bear one another's burdens" and "each will bear his own load" fit together? What would that look like to live out?
- 6. What is the significance of Paul using the illustration of sowing and reaping when it comes to living by the Spirit? Why would he encourage us to not become weary?

Read Galatians 6:14-15 out loud as a group.

- 7. What would it look like to only boast in the cross of Christ like Paul says about himself?
- 8. What does it mean for the world to be "crucified" to us and us to the world?
