Prayer

Take time before discussion to take prayer requests and pray for each member of the group that requests prayer.

Read Galatians 2:4-16 out loud as a group.

1. In what ways can we allow culture to distort the clarity of the Gospel?
2. Have you ever tried to add human effort to God-given grace?
3. Why do we often avoid offense at the expense of truth?
4. Verse 14 says that Peter and others “were not straightforward about the truth of the gospel”. If someone who didn’t know Christ watched your life for a day what would they have to say about the Gospel?
5. How would you answer these three questions in regard to living straight forward about the truth of the Gospel?

What do you allow?
What do you alter?
When do you avoid?

Read Galatians 3:1-18

6. Why is it important to ask yourself how you received the Gospel?
7. What does it mean to try to receive grace through family tradition or cultural confirmation?
Have you ever experienced this temptation?

Read Galatians 3:26-29

8. Galatians 3:26 says we’re sons and daughters of God. How might your day look different if you really believed that identity first thing each morning?
9. What does it mean that in Christ there’s no Jew or Greek, slave or free, male or female? What picture of the church do you think Paul is painting here?
