

Kitchen Staff – Camp Roger

Overview:

Every staff member at Camp Roger represents Jesus Christ and is a minister of the Gospel regardless of the department or position or job duties. God tells us in 1st Peter that we are a holy priesthood offering our daily work as a sacrifice to God. Scripture is clear that everything we do matters and we believe we are called to do it all to God's glory. All staff members at Camp Roger are expected to steward every opportunity for the glory of God and the advancement of the Kingdom.

Qualifications:

1. Minimum age 16 years. Prefer age 17 or 18, Prefer graduating High School Seniors
2. Agrees to sign and to strive to live up to the standards outlined in the Camp Roger Faith and Life covenant.
3. Agrees to uphold Camp Roger's high safety standards (training and expectations provided) and commits to living out Camp Roger's Belonging Statement.
3. Able to work on your feet for long periods and lift up to 25–30 lbs
4. Reliable, punctual, and willing to follow directions
5. No previous food service experience required (training provided)

Duties:

1. Assist Head Cook and Food Service Director in the preparation and serving of food and post-meal clean-up at Overnight Camp. This typically includes 3 meals a day and some additional snack times.
2. Perform other duties as assigned by the cook or directors.
3. Participate in camp programs, this can include leading activities alongside overnight camp counselors, going on overnight camp cookouts and campouts, playing evening games (as long as they do not interfere with kitchen staff duties).
4. Follow all food safety and hygiene standards (training and standards provided by Serv Safe and the Head Cook and Food Service Director)
5. Display a positive attitude and model teamwork and responsibility

Other:

1. Seasonal position, training starts a few days before overnight camp sessions start and is completed after the last campers leave for the summer camp season.
2. Modest housing is available on-site. Kitchen Staff will live with other kitchen staff and interns who are their same gender.
3. All meals provided during overnight camp sessions. Kitchen staff have time-off between meals and between sessions of overnight camp.
4. Will have opportunities to engage with the whole summer staff community and make a positive impact on campers' summer experience.
