Story:

★ **Introduction & Story:**

Our lessons up to now have been about the Old Testament. In the Old Testament, everything pointed to the world's need of a Savior; someone to take away the sins of the world. Adam and Eve were given a wonderful garden to live in, but they disobeyed God and had to leave the garden. After that, our stories often told of sin and problems. Jacob was tricked into marrying the wrong woman. Joseph's brothers sold him into slavery. The pharaoh in Egypt treated the Israelites badly. The Israelites grumbled and disobeyed on the way to the Promised Land. The Israelites often worshipped idols. Jonah disobeyed God and ended up in the belly of a fish! The Jews were taken into captivity and had to go to Babylon. The wall in Jerusalem had fallen down and Nehemiah had to go rebuild it.

But today we are going to start talking about Jesus! Finally, the Savior of the world was coming.

There had been many people that told about Jesus' coming. All through the Old Testament, prophets told the people that he would come.

The prophet Micah predicted where he would be born. Micah 5:2 said it would be Bethlehem. And this was 700 years before it happened!

The prophet Isaiah told us in Isaiah 40:3-4, that there would be someone coming just before Jesus to prepare the way for Jesus. That is what we are going to talk about today.

There was a man named Zechariah. He was a priest in Israel. Both he and his wife Elizabeth loved and served the Lord. They had prayed for children for many years, but no children came. Now they were old and childless, but they worshipped God faithfully.

One day when Zechariah went into the Holy Place to burn incense on the golden altar, he saw an angel standing by the altar. Zechariah was terrified, but the angel said, "Do not be afraid, Zechariah, because your prayers have been heard. Your wife Elizabeth will have a son, and you will name him John." The angel continued to tell him about who John would be. The angel said that John would turn many hearts toward the Savior. John would prepare the people for the coming Savior.

Zechariah was unable to believe the angel. The angel told him that he would not be able to speak until John was born, because he did not believe what God had sent the angel to tell him. So, Zechariah could not talk for many months.

After John was born, the people around them thought that he would be named after his father. But Elizabeth told them that he would be called John. The people turned to Zechariah, and he wrote on a tablet, "His name is John." Immediately Zechariah could speak and he began praising God! All the people wondered what this child would become. Surely God had a plan for him.

John grew up and did just what the angel said he would do. He preached in Judea saying, "Repent, because the kingdom of heaven has come near."

John wore a coat of camel's hair with a leather belt around his waist. His food was locusts and wild honey. The people from Jerusalem, Judea and all the area around the Jordan River were going out to him. They were confessing their sins and being baptized in the Jordan River. He told the people that one was coming that was more powerful than him. He meant Jesus. He told them that Jesus would baptize them with the Holy Spirit.

★ **Connection to God's Overall Story/Plan:** God had asked the Old Testament Israelites to sacrifice animals so that He would forgive them of their sins/disobedience. But it didn't really help them stop sinning. So God had been planning on a better sacrifice – a Savior that would pay the price of sin AND help the people stop sinning. John would remind the people that God was sending the Savior. It had been quite a few years since they were reminded through the prophets.

Follow Up:

★ **Retell:** Have kids share what they recall from the story. Fill in any major holes they missed.

Questions:

1. Did you know there were hundreds of prophecies about Jesus? Most of them were several hundred years before he came.
2. John the Baptist must have looked kind of strange in his funny clothes. He was preaching a message that would have been kind of strange to the people that were hearing it. Why do you think the people were drawn to him? (Maybe God led them to him. They knew the prophecies and were probably really hoping the Savior was about to come.)

3. Did you know that John the Baptist and Jesus were relatives? John's mother Elizabeth and Jesus' mother Mary were cousins. We'll talk more about that next week.

★ **Examine:**

- Ask, "What do we learn about God from this story? What does He do?"
 - He doesn't forget us. He keeps His promise. He has a big plan that took many years to deliver.
- Ask, "What do we learn about humans from this story? What are humans doing?"
 - We can tell others about God.

★ **Application:** Ask, "What is Jesus asking us to do through this story? Why did God include this in the Bible?"

- To tell others about God.

"Prepare the Way" Obstacle Course

Theme: John prepared the way for Jesus.

Setup:

- Create a path using cones, pool noodles, boxes, or chairs.
- Add actions along the way: jumping over "rocks," walking on a "bridge," crawling under a "tree."

Directions:

Kids travel the path "clearing the way" — moving obstacles aside or fixing the path as they go.

Talk about: "John helped people get ready for Jesus by telling them to turn away from sin and follow God."



Shout It Out!

Theme: John boldly told others to "Repent!"

Directions:

- Have kids stand in a circle.
- One child calls out a message like “Repent!” or “Follow God!” while doing a fun action (e.g., jumping jacks).
- The rest echo both the *words* and *action*.
Variation: Turn it into a call-and-response game: leader shouts, kids echo.

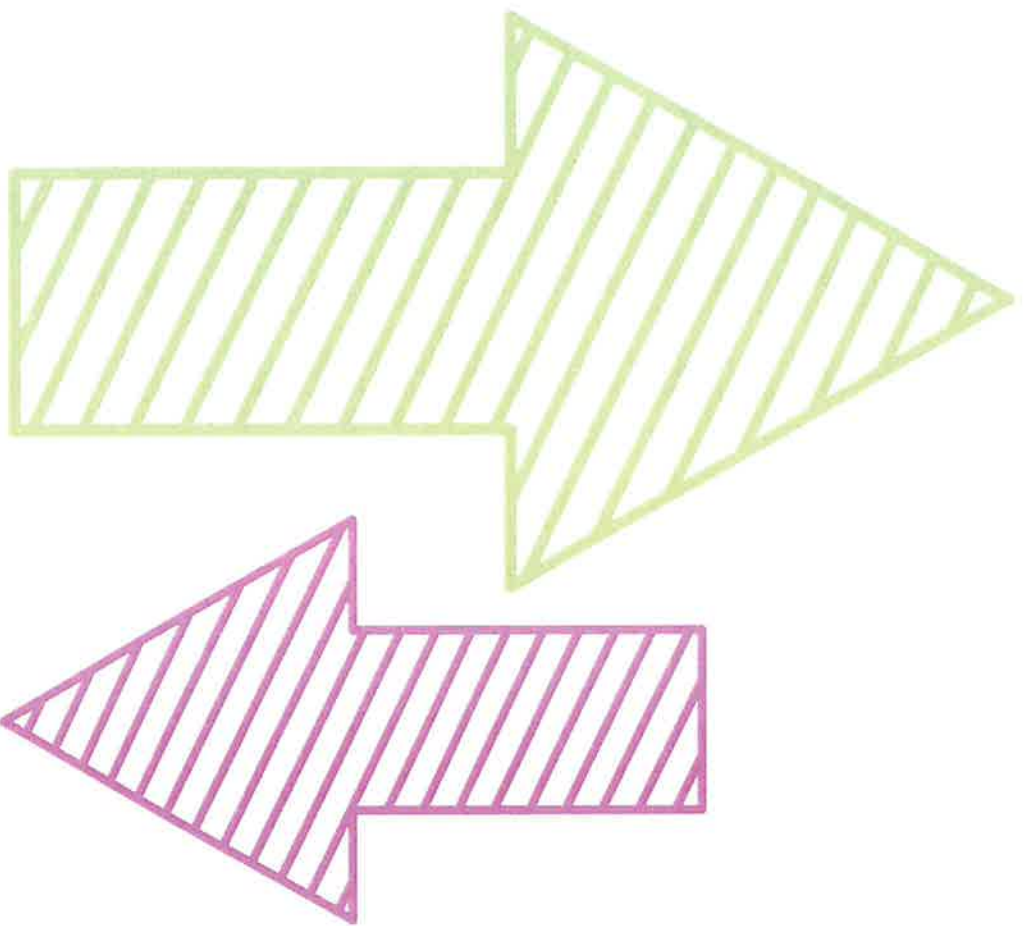

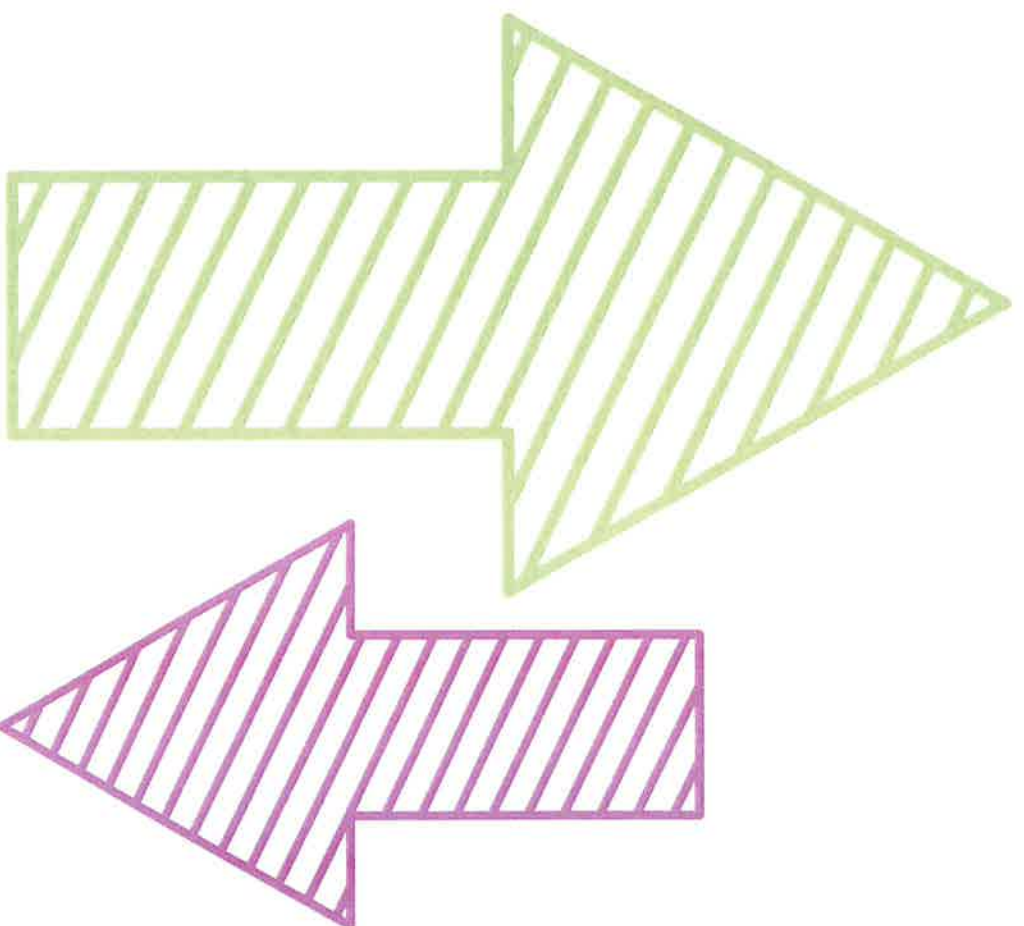

Matthew 3:1–12; Mark 1:1–8; Luke 3:1–20

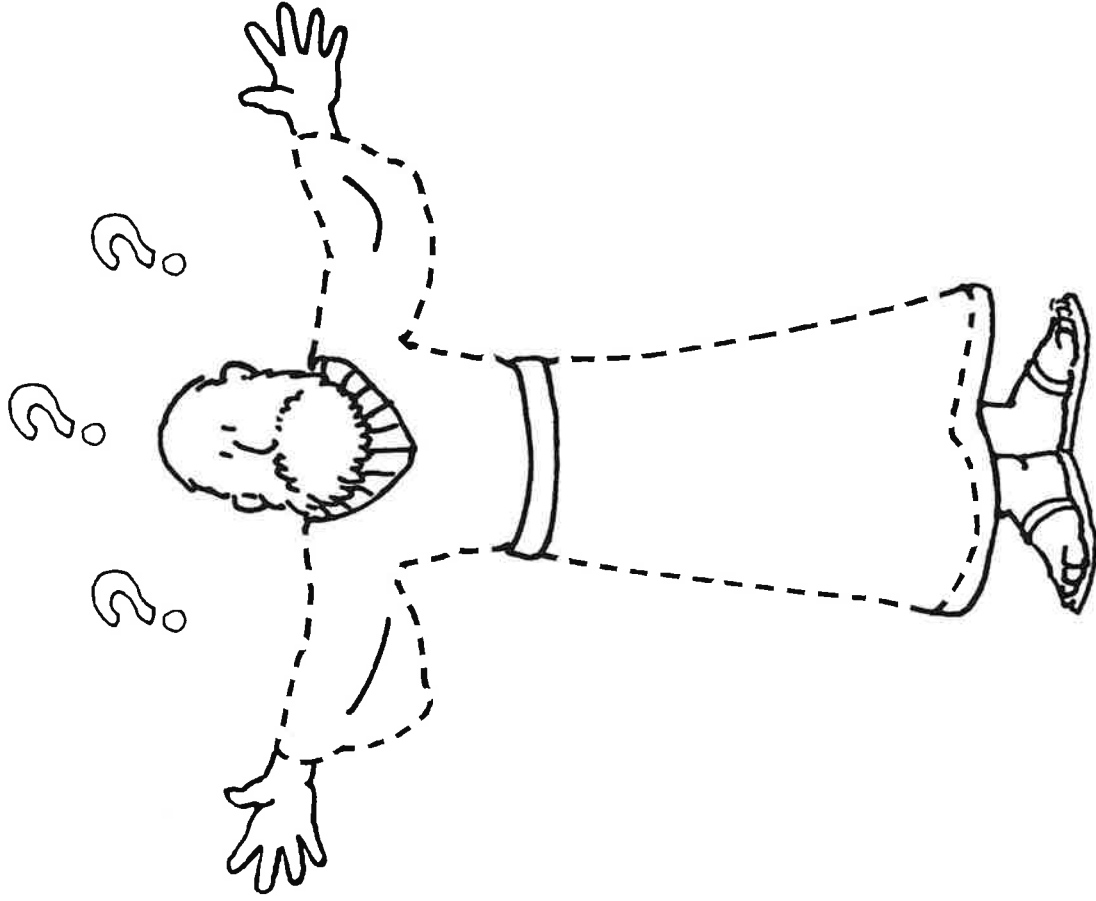

Draw a mouth on Zechariah. Trace his clothes.

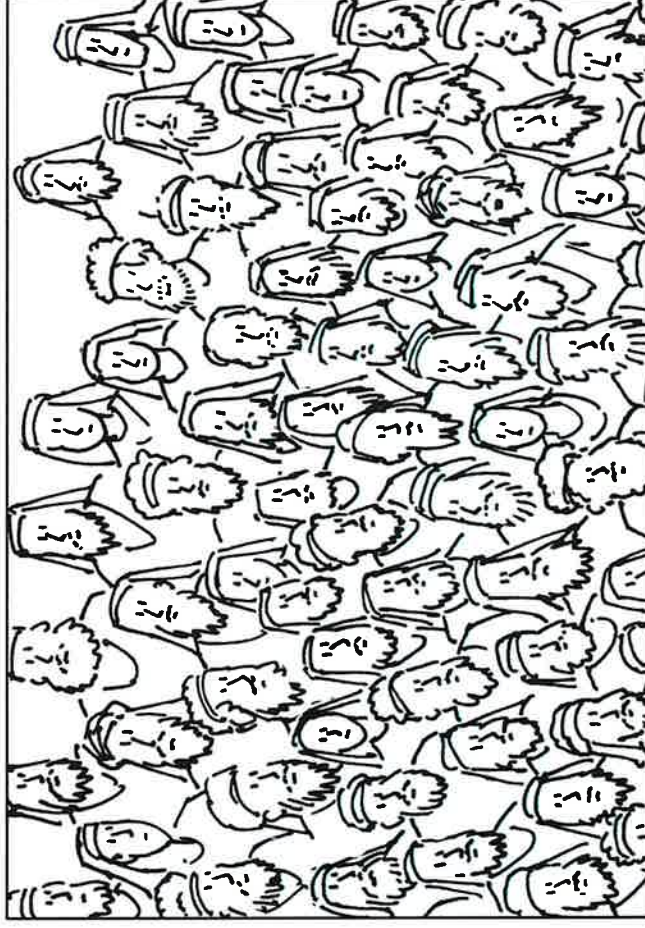

BIRTH OF JOHN FORETOLD

New Testament Lesson #1

Shortly before Jesus was born, there lived an older couple named Zechariah (zek-a-RI-a) and Elizabeth. They were both descendants of Aaron (Moses' brother) and obeyed the Lord. The couple was childless.

Zechariah was a priest, and when it was his turn to enter the Lord's temple to burn incense and offer a prayer on behalf of the people, the people assembled outside the temple to pray.

Inside, an angel of the Lord suddenly appeared to Zechariah. Zechariah was very frightened, but the angel said, "Do not be afraid, Zechariah; your prayer has been heard. Your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you are to give him the name John. He will be a joy and delight to you, and many will rejoice because of his birth." The angel told Zechariah that his son would prepare the people to hear the Lord when he came.

This prophecy seemed too good to be true, considering that he and his wife were old. Zechariah asked the angel how he could know for sure.

The angel responded, "I am Gabriel (GAY-bri-el). I stand in the presence of God, and I have been sent to speak to you and to tell you this good news." Then the angel said that since Zechariah hadn't believed what the angel said, he would be unable to speak until all the things the angel had told him had come to pass.

When Zechariah went out of the temple, he couldn't speak. The people realized he had seen a vision. After he and Elizabeth returned home, she became pregnant, just as Gabriel had promised. She remained in seclusion for five months and gave glory to God for allowing this happy thing to occur.

POINTS TO CONSIDER:

- This angel was probably the same Gabriel who had appeared to Daniel in Babylon many years earlier. See Daniel 8:16 and 9:21. Gabriel had told Daniel of the coming of the Messiah and now was telling Zechariah that his son would be the one to announce that the Messiah had come!
- In verse 5, it says that Zechariah belonged to the priestly division of Abijah (a-BI-ja). Abijah was chief of one of the 24 divisions of the priesthood. See 1 Chronicles 24:10.
- Incense was to be burned on the altar of incense in the morning and the evening. This corresponded to the designated times for prayer by the people, which is why they were gathered outside praying at this time.
- Part of Zechariah's shock at seeing the angel was that no one was to be in the temple with him.
- The name Zechariah means "God has remembered," Elizabeth means "the oath of God" and John means "Grace."

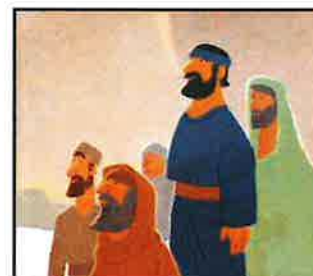
