1. Self-Evaluation - Monitoring my house:

- o Are we effectively focused on our goals and targets?
- Are we effectively spending quality time with each other as husband and wife? Parents and children?
- Are we effectively communicating our emotions and having intimate love that builds our relationship?
- o Are we effectively communicating our financial goals by saving, investing, and managing?
- o Are we effectively sharing household duties together?
- O Do we enjoy our time together? Explain what you enjoy most about your time shared with each other?
- After hearing your mate's expression of their joy shared with you, are you ready to expand the best of you so that they experience the best of you?
- Home life is building the cohesive energy of partnership. We learn how to build each other more than the use of tongues to tear each other down.
- Home life helps us to empower our relationships through teamwork. Creating balance by emotional and physical intimacy and support.
- o Confirming our love, commitment, and appreciation for each other by words, touching and facial expressions are strong affirmation of our love.
- o Doing extra and unexpected jesters reveals your thinking of them, and you value their presence, love, and friendship.
- o Remember that every action and no action reveal the presence of thought or the absence of thought.
- o Sometimes you just need a hug. Human touch is the strongest assurance we experience.
- Thinking well of your mate in everyday life, challenges and changes are a must to the life of your relationship.
- We will all experience opportunities to think negatively about each other, but you must stay on top of your love life!
- Some thoughts that you and I experience are not up for conversation, they are just common thoughts for me or to be cast down and placed under my feet.
- o Do I spark unwarranted anger in my home, do I pick a fight with petty excuses?
- Unwarranted stress over analyzing, overthinking, and questioning every agreement that is made. A double minded man is unstable in all his ways.
- Accepting the truth about your mate that you can't control or change them is necessary for your contentment to live with them.

- Never accuse your mate by assuming without evidence; this will only lead to distrust, loss of communication, and unease.
- o The **foundation** of all relationships must be God.
- The walls of your relationship must be love, trust, and loyalty.
- The **roof** of your relations must be unwavering.
- o You as a person will be tested if you live not tempted by God. God reports no man!
- The person you are meant to become will only emerge through trials. Sometimes, those tests come through your closest relationships—including your mate.
- Your difference, likes, and dislikes will push you to breaking points that you must prove yourself.

Luke 6:46-49 TPT

[46] "What good does it do for you to say I am your Lord and Master if you don't put into practice what I teach you? [47] Let me describe the one who truly follows me and does what I say: [48] He is like a man who chooses the right place to build a house and then lays a deep and secure foundation. When the storms and floods rage against that house, it continues to stand strong and unshaken through the tempest, for he built it wisely on the right foundation. [49] But the one who has heard my teaching and does not obey it is like a man who builds a house without laying any foundation at all. When the storms and floods rage against that house, it will immediately collapse and become a total loss. Which of these two builders will you be?"

[Ps 104:30; Heb 1:2; 11:3] 27So God created man in His own image, in the image and likeness of God He created him; male and female He created them. [Col 3:9, 10; James 3:8, 9] 28And God blessed them [granting them certain authority] and said to them, "Be fruitful, multiply, and fill the earth, and subjugate it [putting it under your power]; and rule over (dominate) the fish of the sea, the birds of the air, and every living thing that moves upon the earth." 29So God said, "Behold, I have given you every plant yielding seed that is on the surface of the entire earth, and every tree which has fruit yielding seed; it shall be food for you; 30and to all the animals on the earth and to every bird of the air and to everything that moves on the ground—to everything in which there is the breath of life—I have given every green plant for food"; and it was so [because He commanded it]. 31God saw everything that He had made, and behold, it was very good and He validated it completely.
