Matthew 25:6-9 MSG

"In the middle of the night someone yelled out, 'He's here! The bridegroom's here! Go out and greet him!' [7-8] "The ten virgins got up and got their lamps ready. The silly virgins said to the smart ones, 'Our lamps are going out; lend us some of your oil.' [9] "They answered, 'There might not be enough to go around; go buy your own.'

What are the life lessons we learn from this parable?

- 1) early preparation is necessary for advancement
- 2) procrastinating—putting things off until later—can cause you to miss your opportunities.
- 3) knowing what is required ahead of time is key to avoid delays
- 4) giving away what you need will leave you wanting
- 5) other people's failures are not your responsibility
- 6) buy in bulk
- 7) don't spend every penny on your investment
- 8) always take care of what is needed before your wants
- 9) training your family to manage is a must for their future
- 10) borrowing isn't altogether wrong, but It's better to be in a position where borrowing isn't needed
