Unblocked 7.27.25

Luke 13:11-14 TPT

he encountered a seriously handicapped woman. She was crippled and had been doubled over for eighteen years. Her condition was caused by a demonic spirit of bondage that had left her unable to stand up straight. [12-13] When Jesus saw her condition, he called her to him and gently laid his hands on her. Then he said, "Dear woman, you are free. I release you forever from this crippling spirit." Instantly she stood straight and tall and overflowed with glorious praise to God! [14] The Jewish leader who was in charge of the synagogue was infuriated over Jesus healing on the Sabbath day. "Six days you are to work," he shouted angrily to the crowd. "On those days you should come here for healing, but not on the seventh day!"

ENSLAVED

Bounded by a demon spirit called BONDAGE, tied up in a position whereby you're unable to free yourself from a mental thought or physical state.

Psalms 142:7 AMP

Bring my soul out of prison (adversity), So that I may give thanks and praise Your name; The righteous will surround me [in triumph], For You will look after me."

Romans 12:3 AMP

For by the grace [of God] given to me I say to everyone of you not to think more highly of himself [and of his importance and ability] than he ought to think; but to think so as to have sound judgment, as God has apportioned to each a degree of faith [and a purpose designed for service].

Proverbs 23:7 ASV

For as he thinketh within himself, so is he: Eat and drink, saith he to thee; But his heart is not with thee.

2 Corinthians 10:3-5 TPT

For although we live in the natural realm, we don't wage a military campaign employing human weapons, using manipulation to achieve our aims. Instead, our spiritual weapons are energized with divine power to effectively dismantle the defenses behind which people hide.
