



Activity 1:

Let's Build

Invite children to find two different items around the house to build a house with—such as blocks, plastic cups, cardboard pieces, or even pillows.

Have them build a house + compare

Use this activity to guide conversations like:

What makes a strong house?

What happens when something is not sturdy?

What could make the house fall down?



Activity 2:

Dress Up

Gather items you already have—maybe a doctor kit, a toy garbage truck, a police badge, a firefighter hat, or even a school bus. Invite children to dress up or play as community helpers and talk about what each person does.

Use this activity to guide conversations like: "Doctors help us stay healthy."

"Firefighters protect people and keep us safe."

"Garbage collectors help keep our world clean."

"Police officers help keep our community safe."

"Bus drivers help us get where we need to go."

Encourage kids to notice how many roles exist in their world and how each one serves others—just like we can serve others, too!
