A man finds a treason in a field, and goes and sells all his old possessions to buy the field that has the new treasure.


A merchant finds a pearl of great value, and sells his shop and all of his inventory to buy the one pearl.






### First Wednesday Soup and Sandwich



## **Sunday School Mission Project**


