During the month of June generous donors contributed \$3,598 towards the principal of the mortgage loan, making our balance \$137,908. It would be amazing if we could get the mortgage down below \$100,000 by the end of December. We thank God for our wonderful property and facilities, yet we want to use the monthly payments of \$5,028 to further our mission here in Temple City.



### **Friends in Deed**

Members and friends of First Lutheran continue to donate food items to Friends in Deed Food Pantry in Pasadena. You can help by putting a few items in your shopping cart and bring them to church. In May, 726 pounds were donated and taken to the pantry. The total pounds contributed since January 2017 is 20,678 pounds. Because of grants and gifts to this interfaith non-profit, they have recently been able to add staff to reach out with even more services to the homeless and the economically challenged. Recently, California State Senator Anthony J Portantino honored Friends in Deed with a California Nonprofits of the Year award.

## **Little Free Library**


