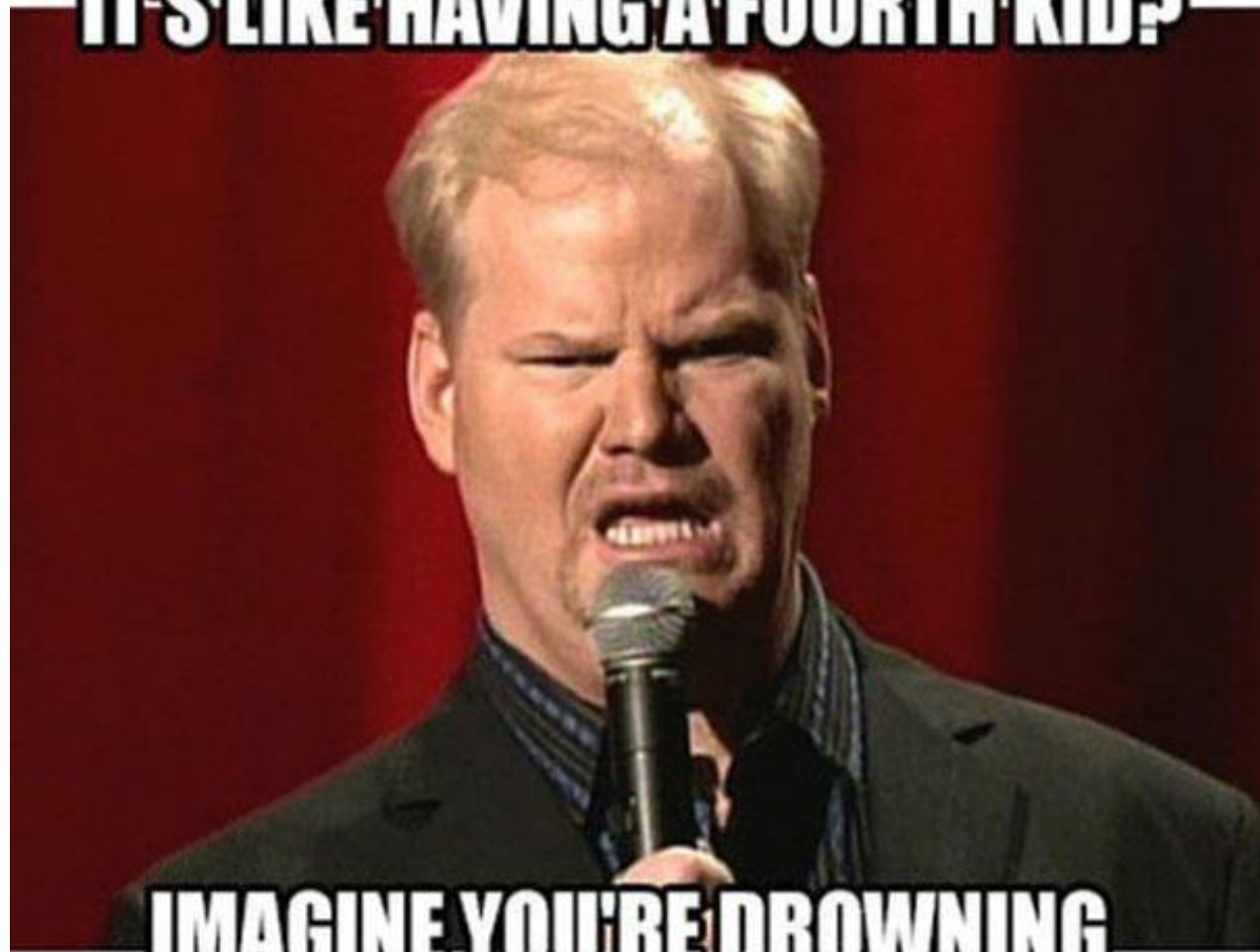

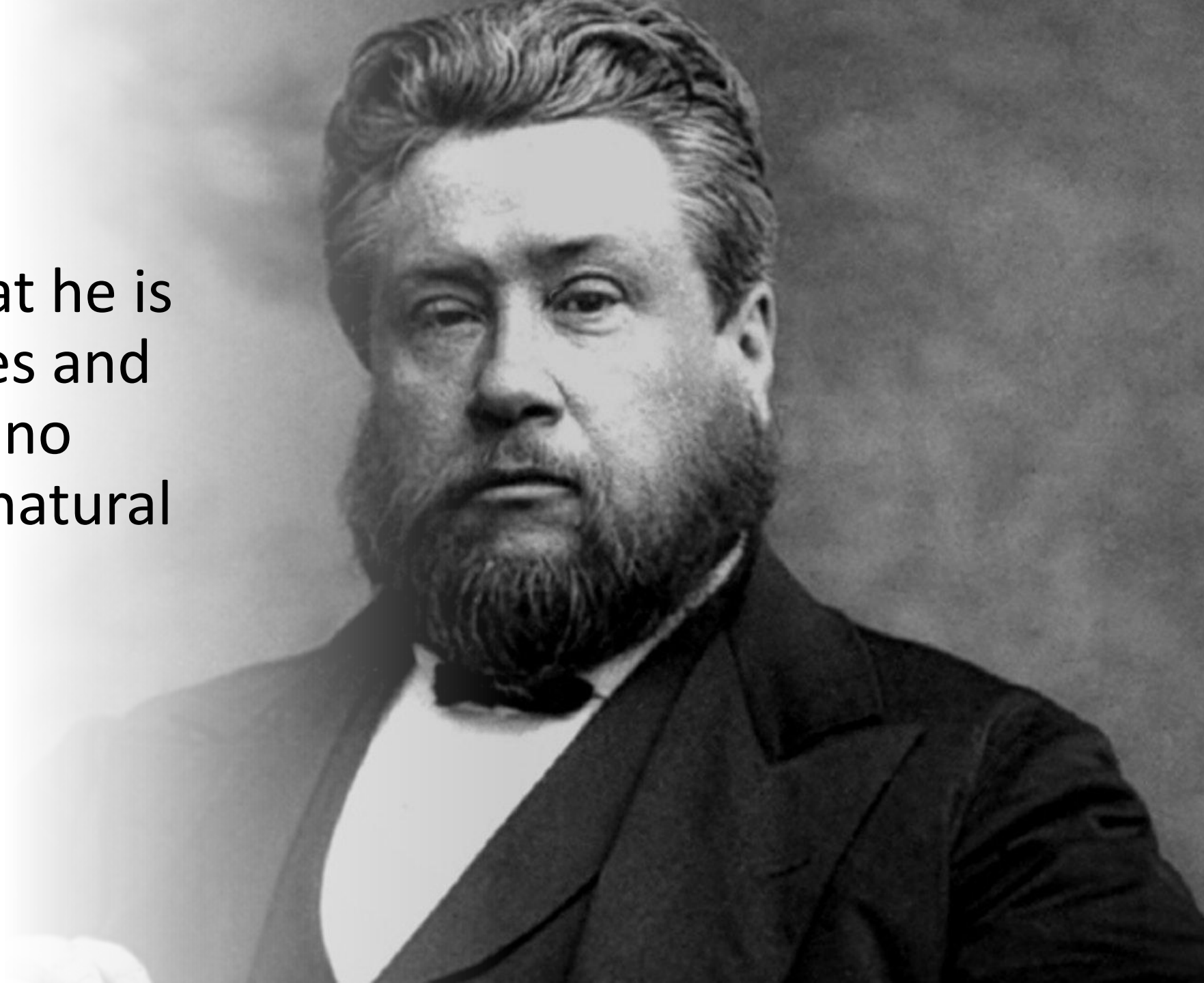

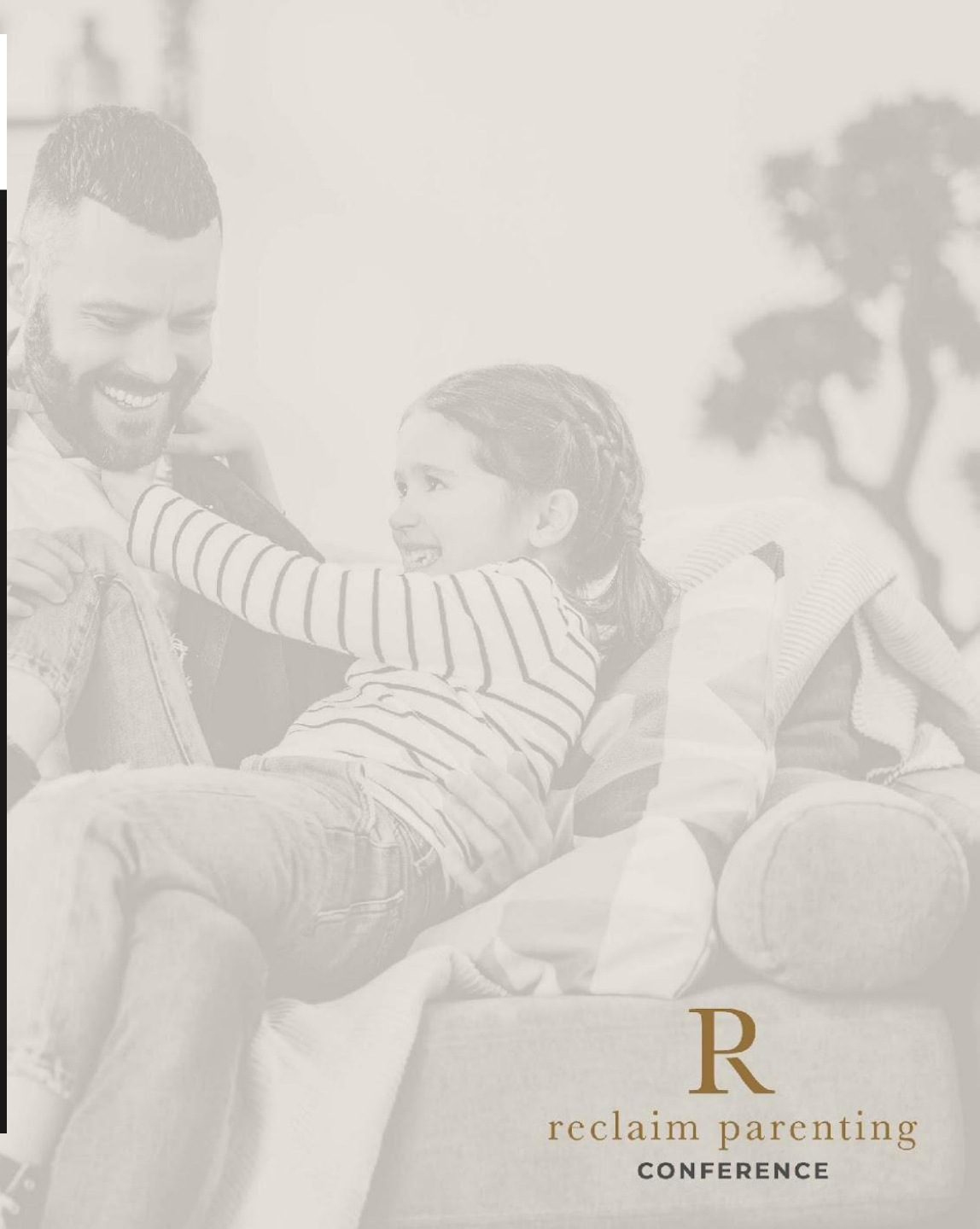


WHAT TO SAY WHEN: Two kids are fighting over the same toy.

Be a sportscaster, not a referee. “Two kids and one blue bike. I wonder how you’ll work that out.”

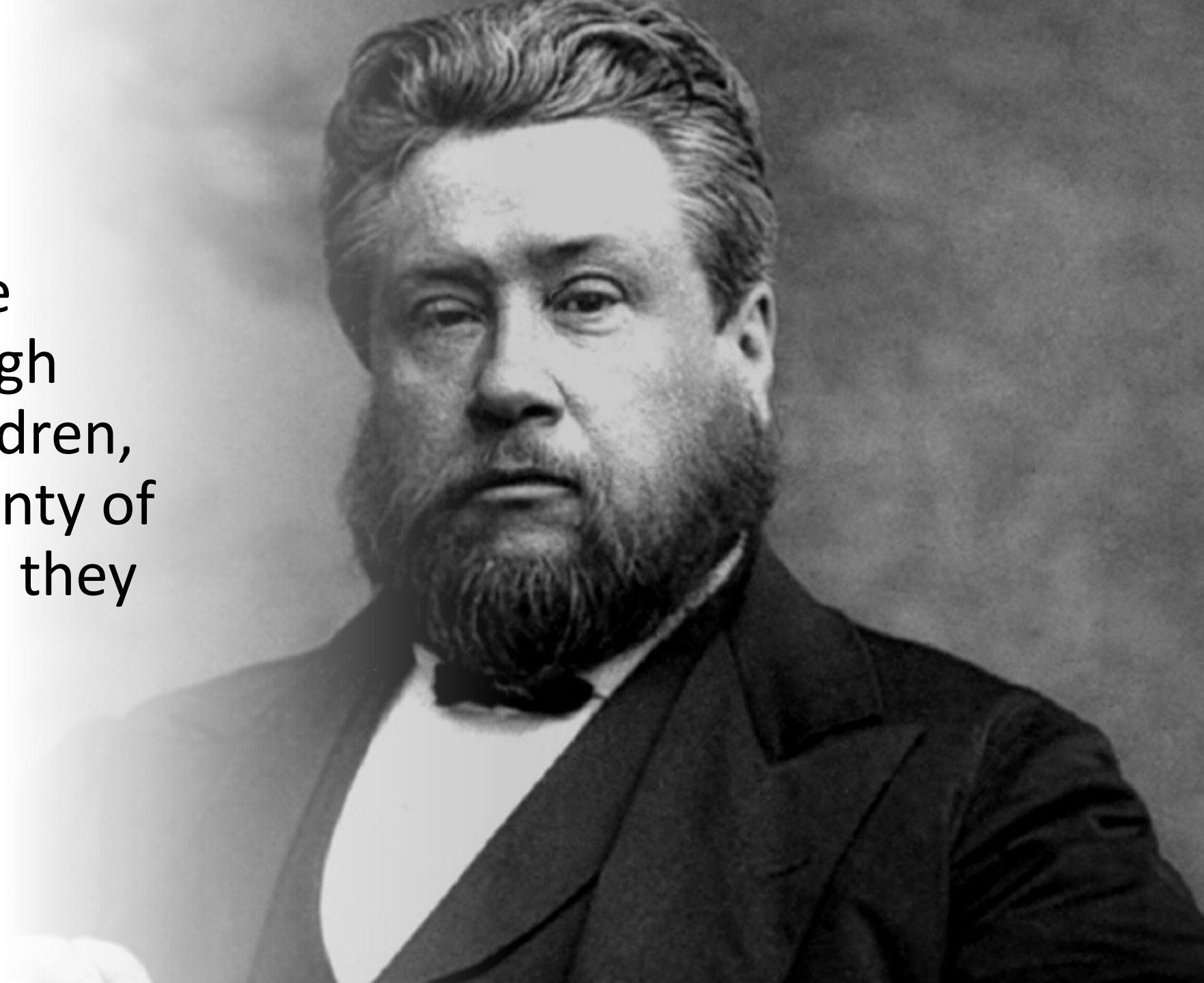
