

MESSAGE SUMMARY

The disciples' tongues were **literally** set on fire when they received the Holy Spirit—and they began to **speak in** *tongues*, a **supernatural language straight from Heaven**. But this gift has been misunderstood, mislabeled, and even mocked. Why? Because it's powerful. **Praying in tongues recharges your spirit, perfects your prayers, and redirects your life.** The enemy fears this gift because it brings Heaven down to Earth and sets believers on fire with spiritual boldness. So here's the question: Will your tongue be set on fire by Heaven... or Hell?

PERSONAL APPLICATION

- Have you ever avoided something spiritual because you didn't understand it?
- If tongues are real and powerful, what's stopping you from asking God for the gift?
- Is your mouth helping or hurting your spiritual walk?
- Would you be willing to start praying in tongues—even if it feels awkward at first?

PUT IT INTO PRACTICE

- Choose one challenge this week:
 - Set a 1-minute timer and try praying in the Spirit each day—no pressure, just obedience.
 - Read Acts 2 and 1 Corinthians 14 this week—highlight everything you learn about tongues.
 - 3. Ask God to fill you with the Holy Spirit—with faith and openness (Luke 11:13).
 - 4. Reflect on your words: Are they steering your life toward God or away?

Ongoing Challenge:

Add 1 minute every month to your Spirit-led prayer time. Build spiritual muscle—one minute at a time.

CLOSING PRAYER 🙏

"Holy Spirit, I want everything You have for me. Fill me fresh with Your power. Set my mouth on fire—not with anger or fear—but with prayer, praise, and boldness. Give me the courage to ask for the gift of tongues, and the obedience to pray in it daily. I don't want a powerless faith—I want a Spirit-filled life. In Jesus' name, amen."



STEP #7 – PRAY IN THE SPIRIT DAILY

Why does this matter?

Because praying in tongues isn't weird—it's a weapon. It builds you up, aligns your prayers with Heaven, and keeps the fire of God burning in your life.
