### CHRISTIAN MEN'S / CHRISTIAN WOMEN'S JOB CORPS \$25,000


Christian Men's /Women's Job Corps (CJC) is a ministry of WMU that provides life and job skill training. Mentors work alongside participants to help them achieve their goals for life and employment. #### **CRIMINAL JUSTICE MINISTRIES** \$125,000

#### **DISASTER RELIEF \$75,000**

The volunteers of Mississippi Baptist Disaster Relief bring help, hope, and healing in Jesus's name to those affected by disasters and crisis situations. Providing services to affected communities free of charge, they seek to show and share the love of Christ. #### **COMMUNITY MINISTRY \$300,000**

Funding is needed to help equip interpreters, train and disciple Deaf, and create ministry materials needed for the Deaf to understand the Gospel in their heart language. Margaret Lackey funds help provide this. Pray for the Lord to equip and send someone to Mississippi to plant a Deaf Church where there is none.

#### CHURCH PLANTING/CHURCH REVITALIZATION \$160,000

Since 2020, churches across the state have been struggling to rebound. We need a fresh outpouring of renewal. Let us ask the Lord to breathe life back into our established congregations, while also praying that He will call out church planters and sending churches across Mississippi to begin new churches to proclaim the Gospel in and among the unreached communities in Mississippi.
