A new Elder can be appointed at anytime between October 25th and January 25th. If a man has the desire and meets the qualifications outlined in scripture then he will be immediately considered for appointment.

1 Peter 5:1-5

Please remember, before nominating a man to serve as Elder you should talk to him to determine if he would be willing to serve.
