ADULT BIBLE CLASSES (9:45-10:30AM)

Young Adult Class (Open to married and single young adults): Faith Foundations - 10 Essential Christian Truths (taught by Craig Parker): Whether you've been a Christian for years, discovered faith in Jesus recently, or are still wondering what it's all about, we all share similar questions about why & how to live out our faith. We wonder: What are we made for? What does it look like to know God deeply? Why are we called to reflect his light to those around us, & how do we do that? Join us in this ten-session video series by author & pastor David Platt as we examine foundational truths for becoming confident & mature disciples of Christ.

Adult Class (Open to all): Romans (taught by Bobby Squire, Mike Arnold, and Keith Hawes): Join us for a 16-lesson study (Spring & Summer) of one of the most influential books of the entire Bible: the epistle to the Romans. This book is both theological & practical. The first half of Romans contains the most extensive presentation of the fundamental doctrine of the Christian faith in all of Scripture. The last half of the epistle describes practical ways that our faith is to be lived out by Christ-followers in any age.

Adult Class (Open to all): "Testify" (taught by Jonathan Guevara and Javier Tapia): The main objective of this class is to understand the power behind testimony. In the Bible the word "testify" is found roughly 180 times, & it mostly refers to expressing what we see & hear from Christ. This class will explore the model of Jesus & the Apostle Paul, as well as the role of the Holy Spirit in the process of becoming a witness who testifies.

Ladies Class: "The Fear of the LORD" (taught by Vicki White). What is missing in your prayers and/or your personal life? What will build a deeper intimacy in your relationship with God? What can make your life more purposeful & focused? What will transform you into a truly Spirit-led child of God? Answer: The Fear of the LORD! Ladies - we look forward to seeing vou in class!
