# Russ' / Our Approach

- Right doctrine, right belief, right thought, right action
- Have a discipleship perspective / desire to be taught
- Begin with no prior understanding of prayer (blank slate)
- Focus only on the text
  - Consult widest variety of English translations possible
- Write down what you see to inform later conclusions
- “All play” several complex passages
  - Discuss at tables
  - Report back
