



God has significantly moved in the life of our church this past year, friends!

A friend recently asked me, "Have you ever been part of a church where there has been this much harvest?" No, he wasn't talking about the wheat fields of the Palouse. Between dozens of first-time confessions of faith in Jesus, more than 60 baptisms this year, a noticeable increase in church-wide missional engagement, extravagant giving, and the multiplication of several CrossPoint Communities, the Holy Spirit is moving in and through you, church! Our faith, together, is alive and well.

Our faith to trust Jesus will determine our future as we follow the leading of the Holy Spirit.

As we look to the end of 2024 and step into 2025, I've been praying for our faith as a church family. My prayer stems from an interaction between Jesus and Peter in Luke 22v31-34.

Here, Jesus predicts Peter's denial of him in the face of coming persecution. Jesus tells Peter that Satan has asked "to sift you like wheat." What does that mean? The answer is found in Jesus' next statement: "But I have prayed for you that your faith may not fail." Denial of Jesus is equated with a faith that fails, and Satan is asking Jesus for permission to cause Peter's faith to fail.

The word *fail* in the original language is the word *ekleipo*, where we get the English word *eclipse*. An eclipse happens when the moon and sun align—the moon blocks the light of the sun, casting a darkness upon the earth. If you've seen this phenomenon, you know it's simultaneously spectacular and eerie.

That is because an eclipse transpires when light is blocked, when something comes between us and the light source that gives life to our planet. The light of the sun should not "go out" in the middle of the day!

Like a physical eclipse, the absence of the light of Jesus can leave us disoriented and confused, tempting us to believe that God has left us alone in this mess.

Here's the reality: Satan's goal for you, and for us as a church, is to cause our faith to fail. His method of achieving failure of faith in us is to place something between us and God so that we cannot see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ (2 Corinthians 4v4). We feel as though we have failed when the light of Jesus is gone, and we are left alone to struggle in the dark.

But here's an even deeper, more powerful reality:

Just as Jesus prayed for Peter, our advocate—the Holy Spirit—is praying for us (Romans 8v26-27) that our faith would not fail. As a faith family, may we quickly identify the things that would cause an eclipse between us and Jesus, resist temptations, seek repentance, and keep our eyes fixed on the pioneer and perfecter of our faith (Hebrews 12v2). Church family, our future disciple-making legacy depends on it!

When our eyes are fixed on Jesus, our faith will not fail and we will move forward in the future God has planned for us. May we as a church find our relationship with Jesus to be unobstructed, living in the light, so that we might trust and fully follow Jesus together.



DISCIPLESHIP PRIORITES



Here at CrossPoint, we're a people who desire to encounter the presence of God, finding life through an abiding relationship with Jesus through the Holy Spirit.

That's why this past year, we introduced Space for God retreats for women—a chance to spend 24 hours as a small group in times of prayer, Scripture reading, and conversation. It's why a group of men got together each quarter for dinner, to talk boldly and honestly about following Jesus as a man in the 21st century. It's why we invited teens to stretch their ideas of worship as we explored ways to encounter the Trinity. It's why we launched a fifth-grade community, engaged kids in prayer events, and spent time in NextGen worshiping through music.

It's why we offer our Sunday livestream service so people can encounter Jesus online—including an elderly woman unable to attend our in-person gatherings, a family new to the area looking for a church home, and a woman whose husband had moved to the LC Valley several months ahead of her.

It's why so many of you have stepped into CrossPoint Communities or have participated in the Rooted experience. These spaces of community aren't just about building friendships and enjoying meals together—they're also powerful opportunities for us to encounter the presence of Jesus.

And at the center of it all sits our commitment to be people of prayer, experiencing the presence of God alone and in community. That's why this past year, we offered four sessions of 24/7 Prayer, including an entire month of prayer during Advent. About 475 of you participated over the course of the year, for almost 800 hours of prayer. So incredible!



Want to hear about the ways God changes lives? You don't have to look far. Just track down one of the 62 people who got baptized this past year.

You see, we are a people committed to God's work—eager and ready for God to transform us so we become like Jesus as he makes us into people of love.

We saw this kind of transformation in Rooted, where our final night together includes cardboard testimonies that reveal how God used the experience to produce change. One person's "before" story said, "I was lost, ashamed, and didn't know Jesus or his story." And their "after" story declared, "I know Jesus! I can leave my past shame." Another went from "No community and in bondage" to "Strongholds broken! Rooted in community!"

Our teenagers experienced the Holy Spirit working in their lives over the past year: Many made the decision to place their trust in Jesus, and many have taken steps of living out their faith, including baptism. We love watching the next generation encounter Jesus and choose to trust and fully follow him.

We've heard stories over the past year of God's healing power in people's bodies. We've been encouraged by stories of dads stepping forward and more actively investing in their kids' spiritual lives. We've watched young

adults build community and step into serving. And we've seen people experience restoration through Stephen Ministry and Freedom Prayer.



Living a Jesus-focused life is a joyful adventure that becomes exponentially greater and more impactful as we pursue our God-given mission together.

We are a people who engage in the mission of God empowered by the Holy Spirit, to see the gospel move forward in our city and our world by doing the things that Jesus did with the same motivations that Jesus had.

That mission has been lived out in countless ways this past year. Dozens of teens and adults served more than 150 kids who participated in our summer sports camp, using sports as an avenue for sharing the message of Jesus. We've celebrated the diversity of people who use their gifts and talents to serve in our NextGen Ministry—from kids to students to grandparents.

Love the Valley remains a powerful way that you tangibly and meaningfully serve your neighbors. Each of the 53 projects this past year was a declaration of the hope of Jesus through the language of service, compassion, and love.

We've found opportunities to build stronger relationships with our local partners—Family Promise, Foster Care, Life Choices, Young Life, and Union Gospel Mission. We continue working with international workers, too, through The Christian and Missionary Alliance, our global church family.

And more than 260 of you serve on one of our numerous ministry teams—including more than 80 people who began serving this past year. Thanks for your heart for God, your love for people, and your commitment to help CrossPoint be a community helping people trust and fully follow Jesus.


