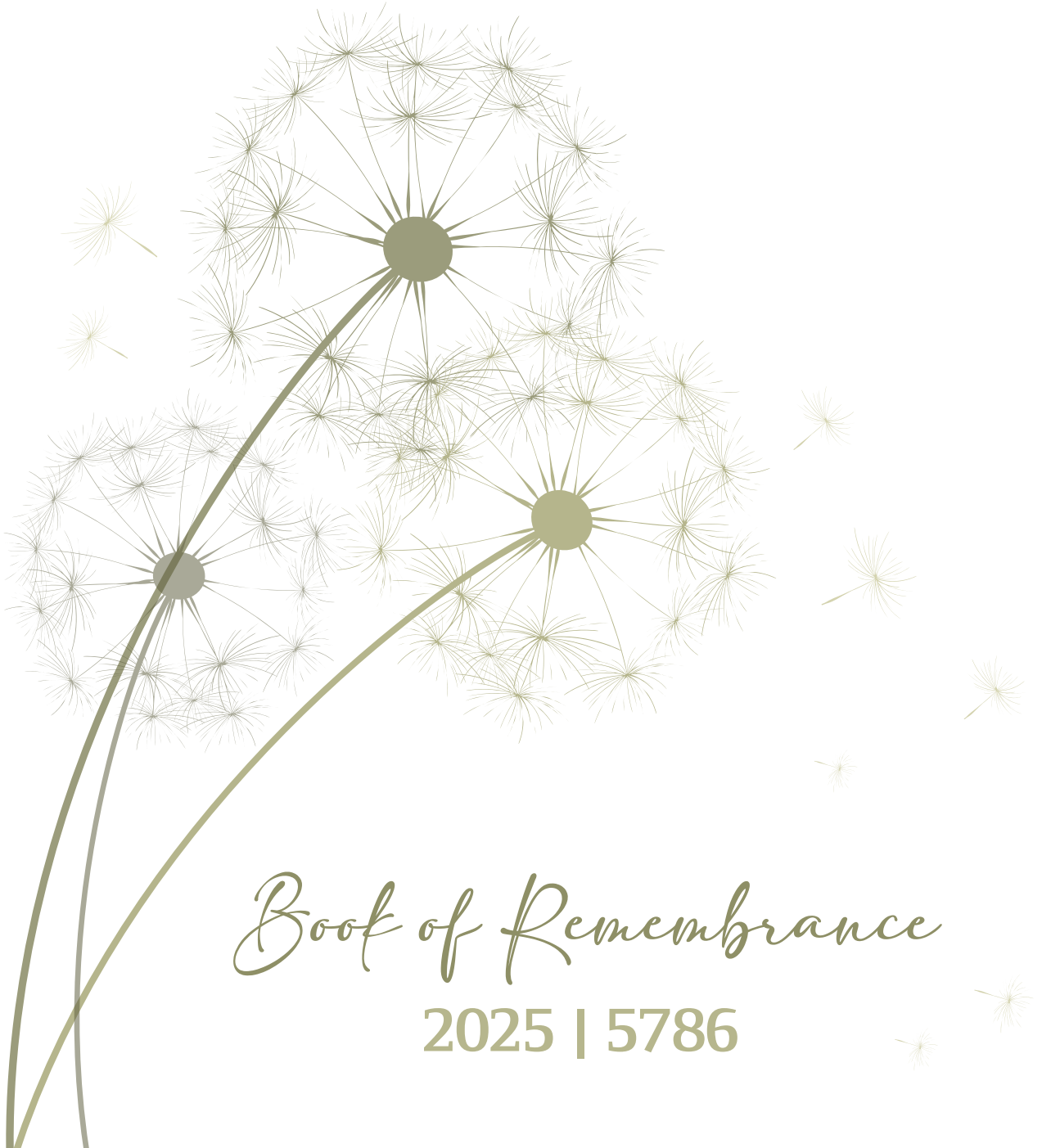



who have lost loved ones during this past year.



The Courage to Remember

Yizkor is not an affirmation of absence. *Yizkor* is our brave acknowledgment of the enduring presence of our loved ones, set so deeply within us that we can almost feel them sitting right next to us sometimes, the shape and texture of their hands holding ours, stroking our hair, touching our hearts. They are in us, and being courageous enough to reach for them – as we always did back when the exchange was immediate and so much easier – is both gratifying and heart-wrenching.

It is less painful to look away in distraction. We all do it from time to time. We must. But if we only look away in distraction, neglecting the prospect of daring moments like this one, we pay an unacceptable price to escape our pain.

On this day of Yom Kippur, strengthened by one another, we say: “I won’t look away, even though it’s easier. I won’t dodge the tears, even though I fear them, for the price of armoring my heart is simply too severe. There is a promise between us – a promise born from the love that we shared – a promise to sustain the story of your life... the lessons you learned and taught... the laughter you enjoyed and inspired... the seeds you lived to plant.”

This is the contract, spanning the bridge between life and death, that we share with our departed parents, spouses, siblings, children and friends whom we hold close on this day. This is how we Jews remember. Let us meet this moment of encounter with bold spirits and ready hearts – and grant a new day to their living legacies.

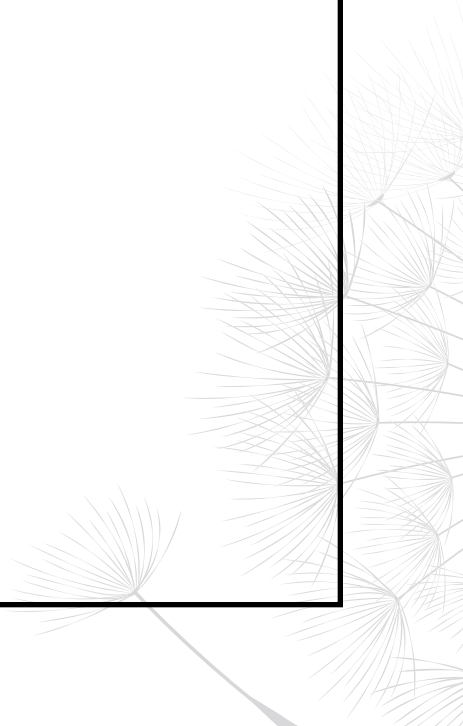



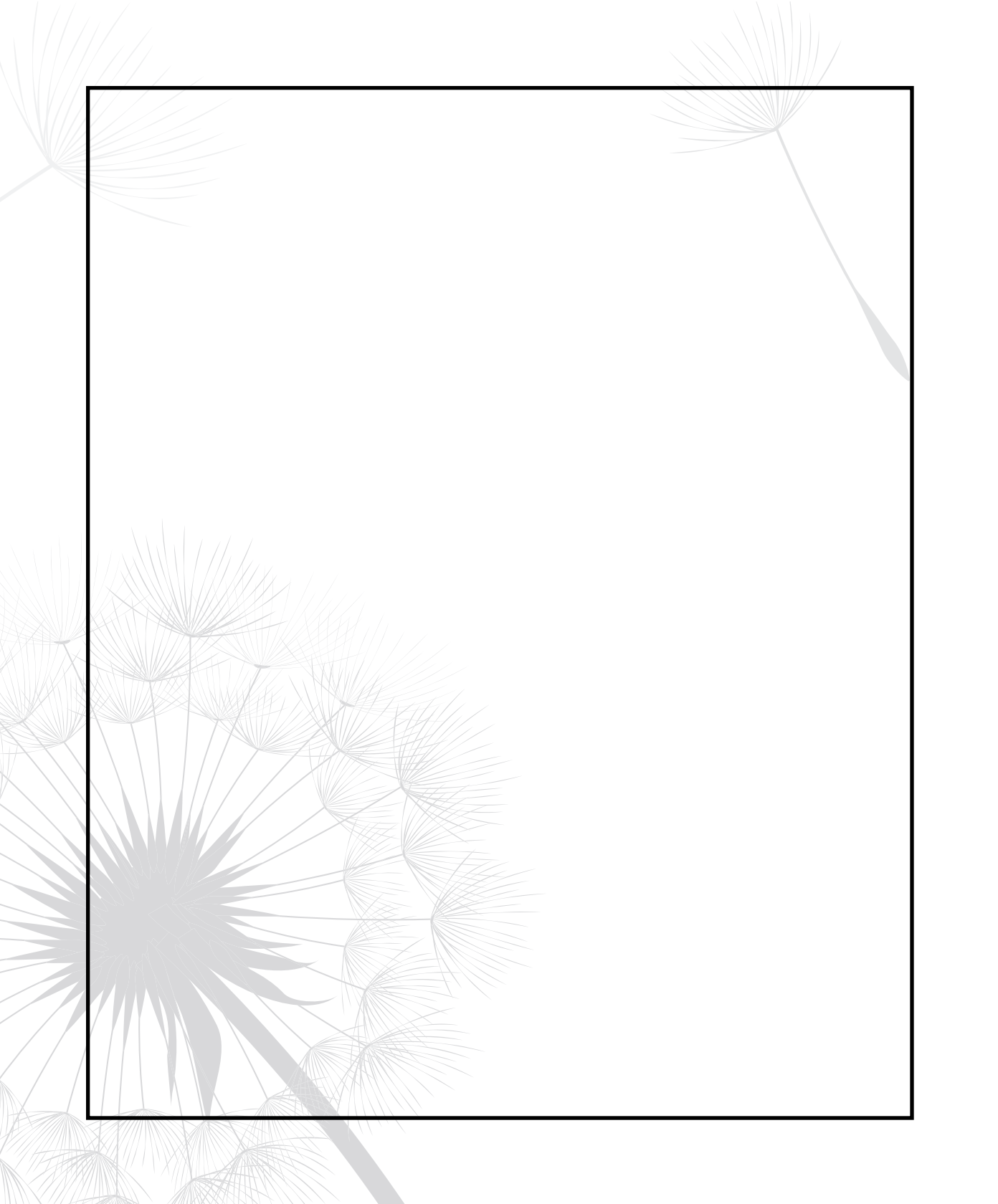
