But God, in His infinite wisdom, knew our need to be here for a longer time in transition. He knew that we needed to reconnect deeply with partners and be refreshed in our vision for gospel living in the every day. He knew that more time for grounding our kids here in the US after several years of Covid would help us all to move forward. God knew that the grief and loss that we felt in leaving Prague and even hurt, needed time to move towards healing. So this year has been hard and sweet, challenging and refreshing, too long and too short.



Psalm 27 says "I believe that I shall look upon the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living! Wait for the Lord; be strong, and let your heart take courage; wait for the Lord!"

As you read this, Lord willing, we have already arrived in London. Our travel is only the start of a new season of transition and waiting on the Lord. Finding a house and neighborhood, looking for places and people to connect with around us, connecting as a Converge ministry team, with our new church family. Those are a few of the early points to navigate. The language, English, is not our American English, and we will have plenty of culture and language to learn. Many Americans struggle with the transition to the UK because they think that the language will allow them easy access to the culture. So we are ready for the work of culture and language learning. We believe that we shall look upon the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living! Join us in praying for God's goodness and hearts full of joy as we enter this new season and the holidays in our new culture and in new relationships.
