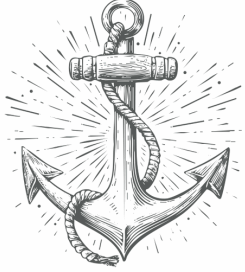


STUDY GUIDE QUESTIONS

- What stood out to you most from Sunday's message?
- Why do you think we struggle so much with wanting control, even when we know God is sovereign?
 - How has control robbed you of peace in the past?
 - How does Job's story challenge the idea that "if I follow God, life should go smoothly"?
- Read Job 38:4 and 42:1-6 together. What does God reveal about Himself in these verses — and how does that shift Job's perspective?
 - How does understanding God's sovereignty affect the way you interpret your past pain or disappointment?
 - Can you think of a time when God's purpose only became clear later?
 - Job didn't get explanations — he got revelation. How can we practice resting in who God is rather than demanding to know why something happened?
- How do trust, lament, and worship each play a role in walking through suffering faithfully?
 - Which of these comes most naturally to you? Which is hardest?
- Look again at Acts 2:22-24.
 - How does the cross show us that God can be both sovereign and good, even in the midst of suffering?
