- **Read Daniel 3**. Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego said, "Even if He does not deliver us..." How does this challenge your view of faith when God doesn't answer prayer the way you want?
  - The Fourth Man showed up in the fire with them. When have you experienced God's presence most powerfully in your own "fires"?
- **Read Daniel 4**. Nebuchadnezzar had to be humbled before he looked to heaven.

  What are some subtle ways pride can creep into your life and faith?
- **Read Daniel 6**. Daniel prayed three times a day, even when it was outlawed. What consistent spiritual practices keep you anchored when culture feels hostile to faith?
  - Daniel repeatedly shows that kingdoms rise and fall, but God rules over all. How does God's sovereignty give you peace in uncertain times (politically, culturally, or personally)?
  - Daniel lived faithfully in a culture that didn't share his values. What practical ways can you live as a bold, uncompromising Christian in today's world?
