STRANGELY DIM – John 21:1-14

Sunday, July 20, 2025

Read John 21:1-14. The disciples went to work (fishing) while waiting for what God would do next. How do you typically respond during seasons of waiting or uncertainty?

Some believe the disciples were going back to their “old life.” Do you think that was the case? Have you ever felt tempted to return to something familiar rather than trust God’s future for you?

Peter jumped into the water to reach Jesus. What does his reaction tell us about his heart? How does this reaction contrast with the other disciples in the boat? Is one response better or worse? How do you usually respond when you recognize Jesus showing up in your life?

Jesus, the risen Lord, served breakfast to his disciples. What does this reveal about His character? What can we learn from this example about how we treat others?

This moment echoes a similar fishing miracle from earlier in the disciples’ journey (Luke 5:1-11). Why might Jesus repeat this experience? Has God ever used repetition to get your attention?

Read Philippians 2:1-11. Jesus washed feet, made breakfast, and ultimately gave His life for us. How can we practically follow His example in our homes, workplaces, and communities this week?
