## Read Jeremiah 1:4-10

- Jeremiah felt too young and inadequate for God's call. When have you felt unqualified for something God asked you to do? How did you respond?
- What does it mean that God's call always comes with His presence ("I am with you")?
  How does this encourage you in your current season?

## Read Jeremiah 2:13

 God accused His people of forsaking living water and turning to broken cisterns. What are some modern "broken cisterns" people turn to today?

#### Read Jeremiah 7:1-11

• The people trusted in the temple instead of true obedience. In what ways are we tempted to trust in religious activity rather than genuine surrender to God?

#### Read Jeremiah 20:7-9

- Jeremiah confessed his discouragement to God. What do we learn about being honest in prayer when we're frustrated, weary, or disappointed?
- Jeremiah wanted to quit, but God's Word was like fire in his bones. What keeps you motivated to follow Christ even when it's hard?

# Read Jeremiah 29:11-13

 This verse is often quoted out of context. How does understanding the exile background change the way we see God's plans for us?

# Read Jeremiah 31:31-34

Jeremiah looked forward to a time when God would write His law on our hearts. How have
 you seen this fulfilled through Jesus in your own life?
