- 1. What stands out to you the most in this passage—Judas's betrayal, Jesus' command to love, or Peter's denial? Why?
- 2. Why do you think the disciples didn't suspect Judas, even after Jesus said someone would betray Him?
- 3. What does Jesus mean by being "glorified" in verses 31-32? How is the cross a display of glory?
- 4. Jesus gives a "new command" to love others as He has loved us (v. 34). What makes His love different from ordinary love?
- 5. Think of a time when someone loved you "like Jesus." What impact did it have on you?
- 6. What does it practically look like to love others like Jesus in your family, church, or workplace?
- 7. What warnings or encouragements do you take from Peter's overconfidence and eventual denial (vv. 36-38)?
- 8. Are there areas where you tend to rely on your own strength rather than on Jesus? How can you shift that reliance?
- 9. How does this passage help you think differently about failure, forgiveness, or second chances?
- 10. In light of this passage, what might Jesus be asking you to confess, surrender, or change this week? How can your group support you in that?
