- 4.Read 1 Samuel 16:1-12. God looks at the heart, not outward appearance. What outward measures do you tend to use to evaluate yourself or others? What might God be inviting you to see differently?
- 5. Advent is a season of waiting and worshiping the lowly King. What's one concrete way you can "bow before this King" this Advent—especially in an area where He doesn't function like you expect a king to?
