I had the opportunity to bear witness to a 12 college athletes trusting Christ, while serving as a guest speaker on mental health and our identity in Christ, at the Ultimate Training Camp with Athletes in Action.

I have been able to sit across from "D", a South Asian College student, struggling with loneliness, and teacher her about the ever-loving and presence of God, which led to her **Trusting Christ** at Design Conference. As I look ahead in upcoming year, I am already saying "yes" to stepping into more opportunities of caring, coaching, sharing the Gospel, and creating opportunities for staff + students to encounter Jesus' love, so that they can then love others well.

I am trusting God for \$14,500

to help me continue to say "yes" to coaching, caring, and resourcing staff in the US and across the globe as they do the same for students. I currently have 6 upcoming ministry trips planned for the beginning of the year.
