- 4. Jesus tells Mary, "Do not cling to me" (v.17). What might you be clinging to that keeps you from experiencing Jesus in a deeper or newer way?
- 5. Jesus commissioned Mary to tell the disciples (v.17–18). How can we be faithful witnesses of the resurrection in our everyday lives?
- 6. Mary went from sorrow to joy after encountering Jesus. How does the resurrection offer hope and transformation to areas of sorrow in your life right now
