1. Why do you think Jesus chose to reveal Himself first to Mary Magdalene? What does that reveal about His character and the Kingdom of God?
2. John “saw and believed” when he saw the empty tomb and grave clothes (v.8). What evidence has strengthened your faith in the resurrection of Jesus?
3. Mary didn’t recognize Jesus until He said her name (v.16). Can you recall a time when God made Himself personal to you in a meaningful or unexpected way?
4. Jesus tells Mary, “Do not cling to me” (v.17). What might you be clinging to that keeps you from experiencing Jesus in a deeper or newer way?
5. Jesus commissioned Mary to tell the disciples (v.17-18). How can we be faithful witnesses of the resurrection in our everyday lives?
6. Mary went from sorrow to joy after encountering Jesus. How does the resurrection offer hope and transformation to areas of sorrow in your life right now
