From Pastor Aaron's Sermon Dec. 28

Paul says pray for Salvations (10:1)

Pray with your mind and your spirit (1 Cor 14:15)

Paul says the reception of blessings comes by prayer (2 Cor 1:11)

He says prayer can keep you from doing the wrong thing (2 Cor 13:7)

He says restoration comes through prayer (2 Cor 13:9)

He says prayer increases love, knowledge, and discernment (Phil 1:9)

Grants deliverance (Phil 1:19)

Reduces anxiety (Phil 4:6)

Produces knowledge of God's will, spiritual wisdom, and understanding (Col 1:9)

Opens Doors to share the word of God (Col 4:3)

Grants maturity and full assurance in what God wants for you (Col 4:12)

May supply what is lacking in our faith (1 Thess 3:10)

Makes people more receptive to the Gospel (2 Thess 3:1)

Can make us "worthy of his calling and may fulfill every resolve for good and every work of faith by his power" (2 Thess 1:11)

Transforms angry men into worshippers (1 Tim 2:8)

Reveals the "good things" that are in you because of Christ, yet to be discovered

(Philemon 6)

Relieves suffering (James 5:13)

May heal illness (James 5:15)

Is the mode of receiving forgiveness (James 5:15-16)

Has "great power" and "works!" (James 5:16)

No wonder we are told to be:

Be "constant in prayer" (Rom 12:12)

Praying at "all times in the spirit" (Eph 6:18)

Pray "without ceasing" (1 Thess 5:17)
