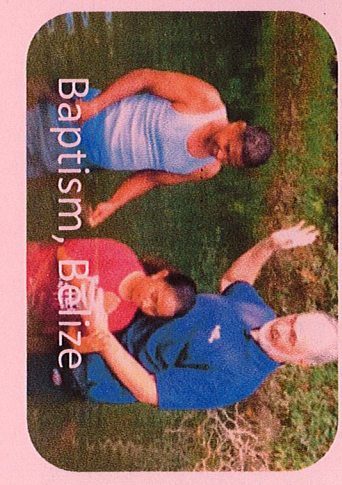

## Mission Journeys - Global Bible School



Greetings to all from Mission Journeys – Global Bible School (GBS). Mission Journeys is working in Appalachia in Kentucky and Belize in Central America. Currently GBS is working in six countries: Philippines, Kenya, Guyana, Zambia, Tanzania and Pakistan.

### Belize

Mission Journeys continues to have a presence in the Central American nation of Belize where Dan and Toni Underwood are in their 14th year of service. Dan reports that the ministry is going better than ever. In Dan's words, the ministry in Belize is both "fulfilling and fruitful." The Underwoods work with a church in the village of Cotton Tree. The Cotton Tree Church is gaining a reputation in the country as a vibrant church.

The Cotton Tree Church continued to grow in 2023. There were 10 additions - 8 baptisms (6 were adults) and 2 transfers.

Dan reports that he has been blessed to baptize somewhere between half to two-thirds of the 50-60 regular attendees. In 2024, the church has a goal of being able to ordain two men to serve as Elders/Overseers. That would be a huge step for the Cotton Tree Church. Please keep the Underwoods and the Cotton Tree Church in your prayers!

### Tanzania

The two-year college started in January with 20 plus students. We are looking for another source of funds for the Welding Program. Plans are in place for a trip to Africa in August and September. In Kibaha, the minister continues to help improve his building. In Dar es Salaam, the minister has gone out into rural areas that are predominately Muslim and has started teaching English using the Bible as a text. We have helped with funds to produce a English brochure that has brought about two baptisms.

### Guyana, South America

I made a trip by myself January 8-15. The time gave Dennis and I the opportunity to look at past, present and the future of the ministry. We spent a large amount of time talking about leadership at Alness Revival Christian Church and studying on Discipleship. I taught for five nights and preached on evangelism. The people responded well. A return trip is planned for April 3-10 with a medical clinic and teaching on Restoration Movement.

### Pakistan

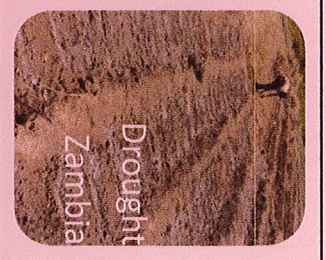
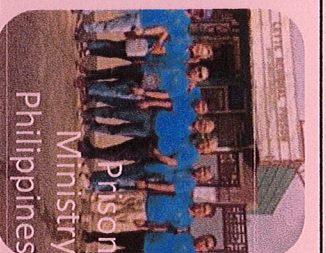
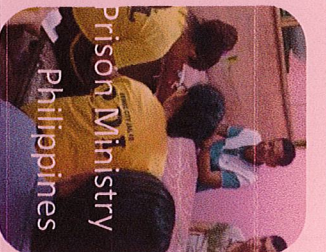
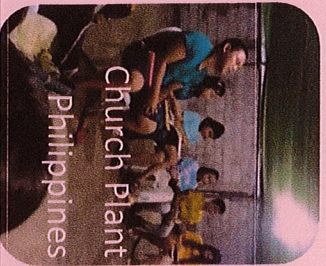
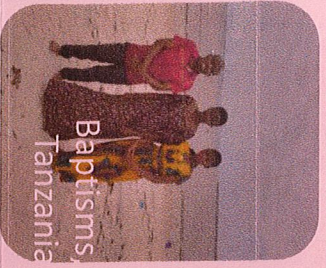
The minister is working with enslaved people working in a brick yard. They struggle with finding clean water. See the picture below of the water they are drinking. A well cost \$1500-\$2000.

### Leyte, Philippines

The new church plant is growing and has had at least two baptisms. We have helped with a prison ministry to provide food, Bibles and hygiene items. Plans are in place for a trip in May. Two classes will be offered: Church History and Old Testament Theology

### Zambia

The country is in a severe drought. Pray for rain to prevent starvation.



### East Kentucky

We have two teams scheduled to work in East Kentucky this summer. One team will work on projects at Bethany Christian Mission. The other team will be working in Letcher County on helping families recover from the flood of 2022. More in our next quarter newsletter.
