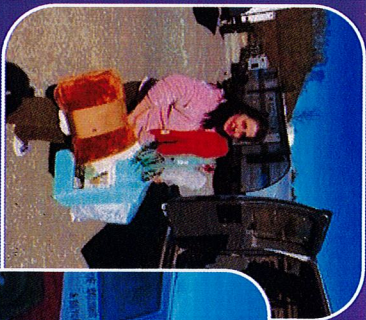




Greeting to all from Mission Journeys – Global Bible School (GBS).

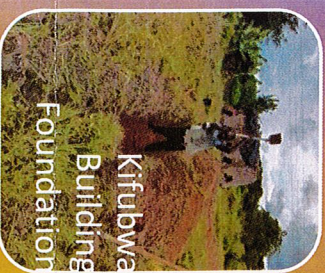
Leyte, Philippines

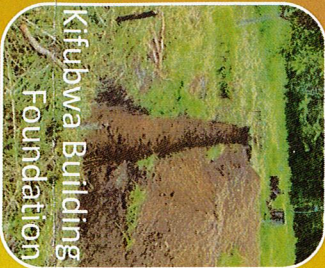
Zambia

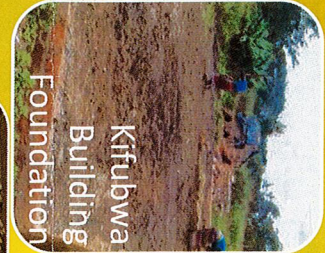
Also, helped the minister with funds for medical supplies. Plans are to return to Zambia in September of 2023.



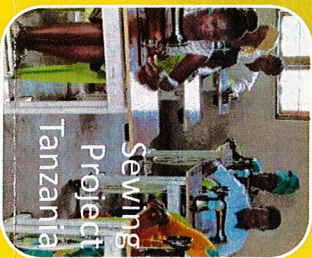

Mbeya and Songwe, Tanzania

The work in Mbeya and Songwe is moving forward. They are currently looking for a place to meet in the Songwe area that meets the current needs of the group. GBS has helped the minister in Mbeya receive a \$7600 grant through IDES. This grant is to support the prison ministry to help women support themselves after getting out of prison. They are starting a sewing training school. The grant is being used to buy sewing machines, supplies, and other needs. The training program is planned to last for seven months with the outcome of having several women trained to support themselves. Plans are to return to Tanzania in September of 2023.

Guyana, S. America

The new building was dedicated on February 5, 2023. The dedication was held in the afternoon with attendance around 300. The building still has construction projects to finish but is a great facility for spreading the Gospel. A trip is scheduled for April 2023. We are planning a three-day medical clinic. Both Dr. Patti and Bill Poczektek will see patients during the visit. I will work on leadership training with the men and spiritual growth with the congregation.

Kibaha, Tanzania

Have continued to assist this congregation with funds for building improvements.

The virtual training of a minister continues with class on Tuesday morning most weeks.
