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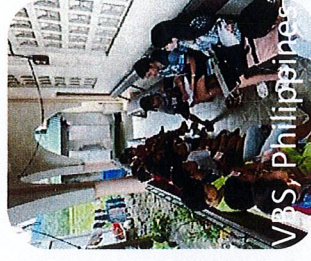
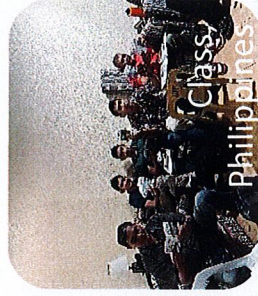

Great Things Are Happening Around The Globe!

- The trip to the Philippines saw great fruit for the Kingdom! Here are some of the highlights:
 - Mission Journeys had a first in their history! We have our first graduates from Global Bible School. We awarded three Bachelor degrees and two Master's degrees in May.
 - We had a record number of 15 students in class during our Hermeneutics and Church Growth classes.
 - We have supported VBS in the Philippines with over 250 children and youth attending at three different churches.
- Dan continues to see in his health decline. He asks for prayer. Overall, the Cotton Tree Church is doing well. Dan and Toni have moved and are now closer to the church.
- Plans are being made for trips to Guyana in October and Africa in August and September.
 - The Africa trip will include seminar trainings in Tanzania and Burundi.
 - Plans include over five weeks in Africa and 28 days of training. Please pray for this trip.

Mission Journeys - Global Bible School

Greetings to all from Mission Journeys – Global Bible School (GBS). Mission Journeys is working in Appalachia in Kentucky and Belize in Central America.

GBS is working in eight countries: Philippines, Kenya, Guyana, Zambia, Tanzania, Rwanda, Democratic Republic of the Congo and Pakistan.



East Kentucky

We delivered two trailer loads of goods to Letcher County, one in February and one in March. We spent four days helping to clean up from the recent flooding. On May 31st, the community center opened for the first time after the flood. We are working with the community center that we distribute shoe boxes with at Christmas time.

Guyana, South America

We made a trip to Guyana the first week of April. The medical clinic and the men's training was successful. We used the Eye Doc In A Box process to conduct eye exams but are still working on fully implementing this process.

Philippines

The trip to the Philippines April 29 – May 20, 2025 was very successful. We had class for 10 days with 15 students each day. We offered courses in Hermeneutics and Church Growth. We graduated our first class of students with two Masters and three Bachelor's degrees conferred. The five men were very excited about the degrees. We had a commencement, including a meal, with over 50 in attendance.

Gabas Church of Christ, the new church plant has continued to grow and is reaching into the community. I had the privilege of speaking there on Mothers Day.

It is VBS time in the Philippines. We have helped with funds for needed materials for the three Churches with VBS's.

Africa – Tanzania and Zambia

Plans are made for a 5-6 weeks trip to Africa in August/September. We will spend time in Tanzania and Burundi. We will hold seminars in 13-15 different locations with a total of at least 27 day of teaching.

The DRC is at war, which has impaired our plans to return this fall. Please pray for these brothers and sisters.

In Kibaha, we continue to help improve the building with the purchase of building materials.

In Dar es Salaam, the minister has changed location for Sunday Worship but is struggling during the rainy season to keep dry during service.

In Zambia, the minister has started a new Church in Muzabula. There are 20-30 in attendance each week and has had one baptism of a former Jehovah's Witness.

Belize – Dan and Toni Underwood

June 14, 2025, marks 15 years of ministry completed in Belize! They have raised funds to purchase a 2014 Ford F150 for the work of the mission. There have been 5 baptisms at the Cotton Tree Church so far in 2025!
