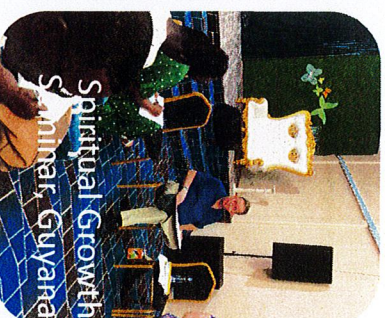

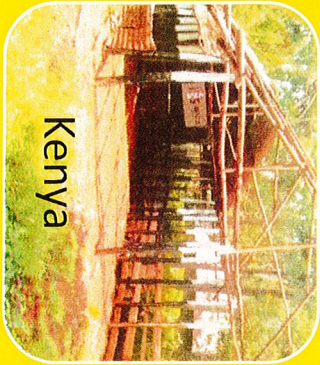

Greeting to all from Mission Journeys – Global Bible School (GBS).

Currently GBS is working in five countries: Philippines, Guyana, South America, Zambia, Tanzania and Pakistan. In September we will begin working in Kenya. Each country has different needs requiring different support through GBS. The following are details on how GBS is serving in each of these countries.



Kenya

Mbeya and Songwe, Tanzania

The work in Mbeya and Songwe is moving forward. The training program for ex-prison inmates continues. They have completed the first three month of a seven month program. The outcome is to have several women trained to support themselves.

Plans are in process for a return trip to Tanzania in August and September of 2023. Ivan Spencer, the minister at Fox Creek Christian Church will go with me for the first two weeks. Both of us will lead seminars in Mbeya, Songwe, Kibaha and Dar es Salaam. After Ivan returns home, I will continue seminar training in Mwanza and Shinyanga, Tanzania and in the Kisii region of Kenya.

Kenya

I have been invited to work with International Bible School (IBS) in Kenya. IBS is very similar to GBS. There are seven Churches and an orphanage that I will have the opportunity to share the Gospel and have seminars to strengthen them spiritually. More in the next newsletter.

Zambia

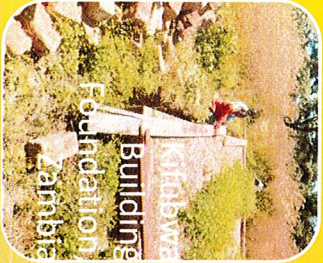
Have continued to support the new church work in Kifubwa with funds for building materials. The foundation has been completed. The next step is to start on the walls.

Leyte, Philippines

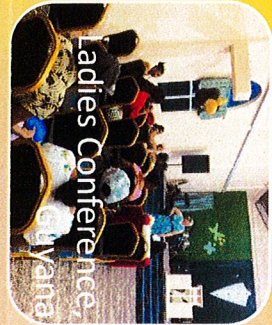
A trip to the Philippines was completed in May. We had ten days of training on Pastoral Counseling. There is a great need for counselors. In Leyte, where we are training, the men indicated that the closest counselor is three hours away. We are training in Pastoral Counseling which has limitations but will be of great help to the people in their congregations. I have met with the attorney and I am encouraged that things have started to progress with the property.

Guyana, South America

We made a trip to Guyana in April. Both Dr. Pati and Bill Poczatek saw patients during the visit. We had a three-day medical clinic with over 70 people seen. They made over 6 house calls to people who could not get to the clinic. We were able to provide a limited amount of over-the-counter and prescription medications. We handed out reading glasses to those needing them to read. We had an evening of leadership training with the men, with various ages and experiences in the group. Dr. Pati held a ladies conference on prayer and was attended by women from Alness Revival Christian Church and the surrounding churches. We had two nights working on spiritual growth plans for people in the congregation. This was well received and will be used by the minister and men to determine where teaching is needed.



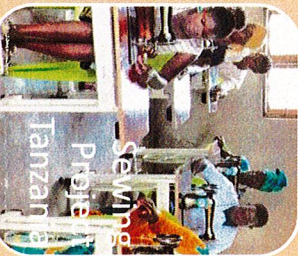

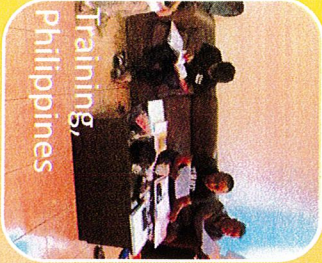
