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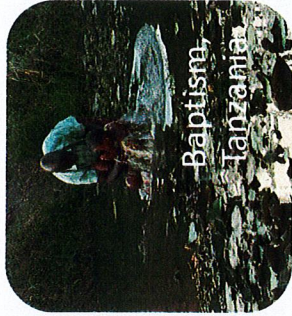
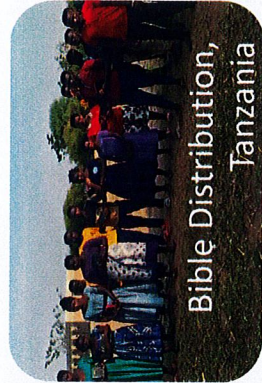

Great Things Are Happening Around The Globe!

- The trip to Africa had several wonderful highlights:
 - We presented seminars in Burundi for the first time. We were there for three days and on the last two days we had over 150 present each day. The people were very receptive of the materials we presented.
 - There were 61 baptisms in Tanzania. We had baptisms in four locations. There were 24 baptisms in Nyanguge and 30 baptisms in Sumve.
 - We distributed over 80 Bibles during the trip. Each person who was baptized received a Bible and other Christians who did not have a Bible received one.
- Dan continues to see his health decline and continues to ask for prayer.
- Plans are being made for a trip to India in March of 2026.
- Shoes boxes are being stuffed for distribution during Christmas in three locations during the month of December.

Mission Journeys - Global Bible School

Greetings to all from Mission Journeys – Global Bible School (GBS). Mission Journeys is working in Appalachia in Kentucky and Belize in Central America. GBS is working in nine countries: Philippines, Kenya, Guyana, Zambia, Tanzania, Rwanda, Democratic Republic of the Congo Burundi and Pakistan.

East Kentucky

We delivered a trailer load of goods to Letcher County in August. The community center has continued to make strides to recover after the flood in February. In December, we plan on distributing Christmas shoe boxes.

Guyana, South America

Plans are made to return to Guyana in October for 8 days. The schedule includes a three-day medical clinic, leadership training and teaching sessions with the congregation. We hope in the future to implement the Eye Doc In A Box process.

Philippines

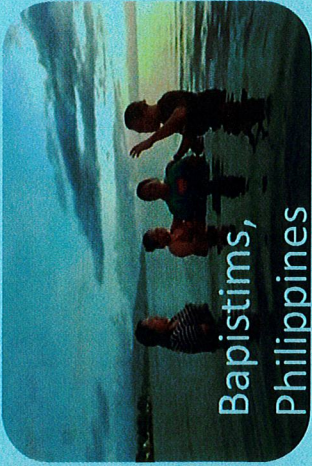
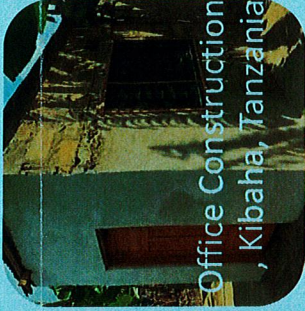
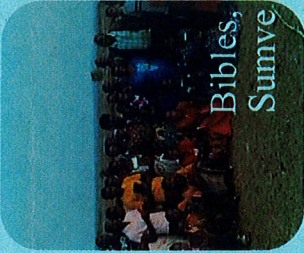
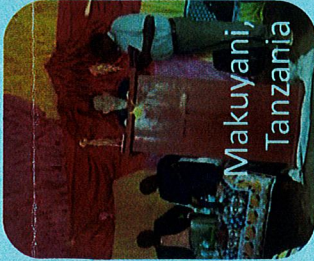
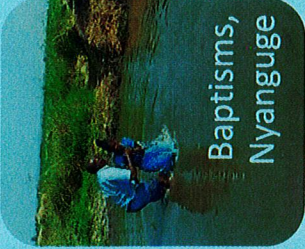
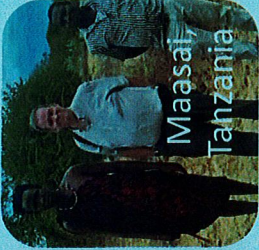
The Gabas Church of Christ (new church plant) had two baptisms in June. There are four weekly small groups meeting, with two of the groups are being led by members of the church. In October we are starting an online leadership class with five leaders of the Balugo Church of Christ. These men are trying to better understand their roles as leaders in the church.

Africa – Tanzania and Zambia

In August/September we completed a 5-6 weeks trip to Africa. We worked in Tanzania and Burundi in 16 different locations for a total of 27 days, taught over 700 people. We had baptisms in Mbeya (1), Iringa (4), Nayangue (24) and Sumve (30) For a total of 61 For the trip. We distributed 80 Bibles. We had the opportunity to teach men from the Maasai tribe. We had the opportunity to teach about the Gospel on the radio in Mbeya. The DRC continues to be at war. Please pray for these brothers and sisters. In Kibaha, we visited this location after two years. He has made great use of the building materials we helped him purchase by adding concrete to help with water control and built a small office for the church and the International Bible School. He has several students attending the school. In Dar es Salaam, we visited the new location of the church. The minister continues to develop the ministry in the new location. In Zambia, the minister has started a new Church in Muzabula. There are 20-30 in attendance each week and has had one baptism of a former Jehovah’s Witness.

Pakistan

The minister has had over 130 baptisms in 2025. The people are responding to the Gospel message. The minister is also, working on leadership training. We have helped with baptism related expenses.
