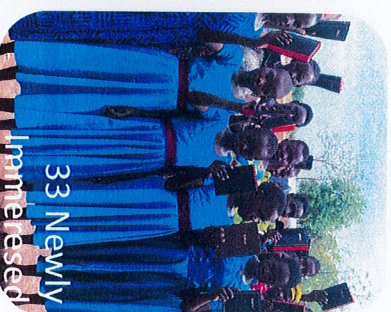
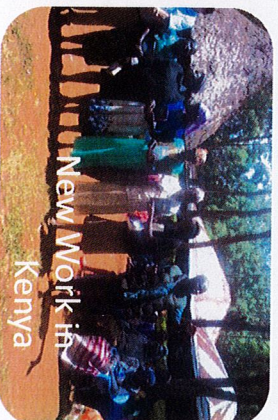
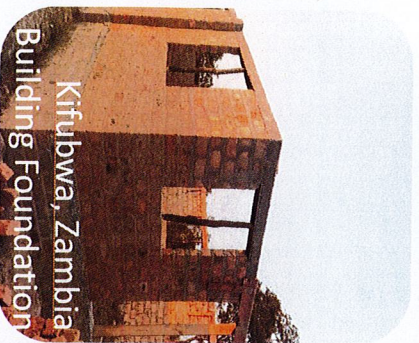

2023 is Off to a Great Start!

- The new Church building in Kifubwa, Zambia has moved forward with its walls completed.
- We started working in Kenya with an IBS work that has started several Churches and is involved in an orphanage.
- Global Bible School and IDES helped the prison ministry start an ex-inmate sewing classes in Mbeya, Tanzania in March of 2023. The first class of graduates have completed the training. There were seven baptisms and a new Church started due to this program.
- We spent five days working in the north west part of Tanzania. In one of the locations, we had 33 baptisms.

Greeting to all from Mission Journeys – Global Bible School (GBS).

Currently GBS is working in six countries: Philippines, Kenya, Guyana, South America, Zambia, Tanzania and Pakistan. In September we will begin working in Kenya. Each country has different needs requiring different support through GBS. The following are details on how GBS is serving in each of these countries.

Pakistan

Please pray for Christians in Pakistan. In the last few weeks over 20 Churches and 200 homes of Christians have been burned. There are Christians who are being imprisoned and even killed for their faith. The minister I have been working with virtually is struggling and has stopped having services.

Leyte, Philippines

The new Church plant in Bay Bay has started. The minister, Abel Pitogo, resigned from the Church he has served for several years to start this new congregation. The pictures show them getting the building ready for Abel and his family to live in, have services and youth events.

Zambia

Have continued to support the new church work in Kifubwa with funds for building materials. The walls has been completed. The next step is to start on the roof

On the Africa trip over 1400 were in attendance. This is a duplicate count because individuals attended for multiple days.

Over 300 Bibles were given out in Africa and Pakistan due to a generous VBS offering from Mt. Eden Christian Church, Lexington

Tanzania and Kenya Trip August-September 2023

The 31 day trip to Africa started on August 14th. Ivan Spencer, Minister at Fox Creek Christian Church, went with me for the first two weeks of the trip in Tanzania.

We started with three days of seminars and house-to-house evangelism in Songwe. We visited over 35 homes over the course of three days. In the afternoons we taught basic seminars about the Gospel and being a Christian.

Next we went to Mbeya and visited the Sewing Training program started through IDES and spent three days in seminars on Discipleship, Spiritual Growth, being a Christian and Ivan preached on Sunday. There was one baptism during our time in Mbeya.

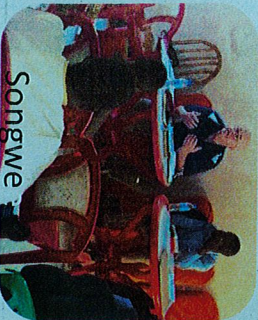
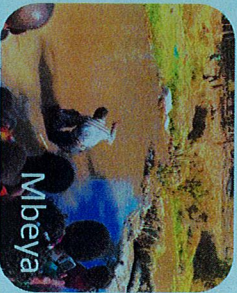
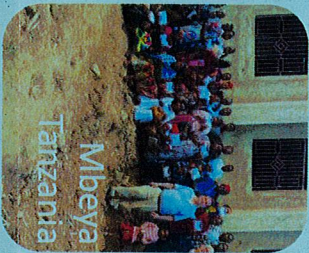
We returned to the Dar es Salaam area and spent two days in Kibaha and three days in a new work started by Helman John. In both of these locations we taught basic seminars on the Gospel, being a Christian, Discipleship and Ivan preach for Sunday service.

Ivan returned home and I went to Kenya.

In Kenya I went to seven different locations. In each location I taught seminars on the Gospel and being a Christian. I preached the Sunday service. For the first day there were over 300 in attendance. The tribal Chief and local leaders were in attendance. They closed five to six schools for the day so students could attend.

Next I went back to Tanzania and went to Shinyanga where I taught Seminars on the Gospel and being a Christian for two days.

Next I went to a rural area 30 miles east of Mwanza. I was there for three days where the ministers from three rural churches came together in one locations for the seminars. I taught the basics of the Gospel and what it means to be a Christian. This group was hungry for the Gospel and 33 people were baptized.



Guyana, South America

A trip is scheduled for November 1-8, 2023. Plans are for a medical clinic and training on Restoration Movement.
