

# **†PROFESSION OF FAITH COLOSSIANS 1:15-20**


(Congregation reads bold print)

#### **CONFESSION OF SIN**

As Christians, we rebel against God's law, and because we do, we're called to confess our sins and to repent of our sins. It's not because the sins are merely a matter of our self-expression, but because they are objectively, morally wrong sins against God. When we confess our sins, we don't go before God to confess feeling badly about what we do. We go to God to confess our sins because we have broken His law.
