Sharing God's Story and Looking for Gospel Moments

A gospel moment is an opportunity in everyday life where God is already at work. You're not starting from scratch. You're stepping into a story that God has already begun in someone's heart!

Gospel moments are all around us and we just need eyes to see and ears to hear the Spirit's prompting. Often, the opportunities are there. We just need the awareness and boldness to respond.

Read Acts 8: 26-40 Philip and the Ethiopian Eunuch - This passage shows us three key things:

- 1. Philip listened to the Spirit's prompting.
- 2. He took initiative and asked a question.
- 3. He shared Jesus when the door opened."

Today, we will learn how to recognize Gospel moments and practice sharing God's story.

How to recognize Gospel moments:

- Look for *spiritual curiosity*—people asking deeper questions.
- Notice emotional openness or pain—this often signals spiritual hunger.
- Pay attention to the *Holy Spirit's nudges*—those moments you feel prompted to say or do something."

Discuss times you noticed any of the above during conversations with others. Did you act on them? Why or why not?

Gospel Resources:

Watch the different gospel illustrations provided below. Choose the one with which you feel the most comfortable (and confident!) and then break into groups of two or three and practice sharing with one another.

- The Three Circles Illustration starts with our brokenness, making it an easy place to begin a gospel conversation.
- The Bridge Illustration gives a simple metaphor of how we can bridge the gap in the relationship between us and God.
- The Romans Road is a simple use of several Bible verses in Romans to share about sin and God's solution.
