Nearly two centuries before Christ was born, a Jewish rabbi named Yose ben Yoezer gave this instruction to his students: "Let your house be a meeting place for the sages, and sit in the very dust of their feet, and drink in their words with thirst." To sit in the dust of a teacher's feet was to take the posture of a humble learner, a true disciple. And this is exactly what Mary of Bethany did the day Jesus entered her home.

Luke records the scene:

"Now as they went on their way, Jesus entered a village. And a woman named Martha welcomed Him into her house. And she had a sister called Mary, who sat at the Lord's feet and listened to His teaching. But Martha was distracted with much serving. And she went up to Him and said, 'Lord, do you not care that my sister has left me to serve alone? Tell her then to help me.' But the Lord answered her, 'Martha, Martha, you are anxious

and troubled about many things, but one thing is necessary. Mary has chosen the good portion, which will not be taken away from her" (Luke 10:38–42).

Mary was so captivated by Jesus that she left her sister Martha to prepare the meal alone, while she planted herself at the Master's feet. What an extraordinary, history-shifting moment this was.

In first-century Judaism, women were not permitted to study with rabbis. In fact, the prevailing view was harshly restrictive, as reflected in these rabbinic sayings from the Mishnah:

"If a man gives his daughter knowledge of the Law, it is as though he taught her to be sexually promiscuous" (Sotah 3:4).

"He who talks much with women brings evil upon himself, neglects the study of the Law, and in the end will inherit Gehenna" (Avot 1:5).

To our modern ears, these words sound shocking—repressive and unthinkable. Yet it was into this very context that Mary, a Jewish woman of the first century, courageously broke cultural

barriers. She sat in the very dust of Christ's feet, drinking in His words with thirst, taking her place as a disciple of the Lord of glory.

As she sat there listening, I imagine she was discovering what the people of Nazareth had felt when they first heard Jesus teach: "They marveled at the gracious words coming from His lips" (Luke 4:22). She was also experiencing what the temple officers meant when they testified, "No one ever spoke like this Man" (John 7:46), and what Peter expressed when he said to Jesus, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life" (John 6:68).

At this point in Mary's life, I wonder what she truly understood about Jesus. Did she know in her heart that He was the Messiah? Did she sense that He was the eternal Son of God who had come down from heaven to dwell among men? Did she realize that she was hearing the very voice of the Creator of the Universe? Could she have imagined how His words would one day change the course of history? Probably not.

More likely, she simply recognized the moment as a sacred opportunity to receive wisdom from a dear family friend—yet she seized it with a willing heart. What wisdom she showed. And what

a holy privilege it was to sit at His feet.

This brief portrait of Mary reminds us that sitting at Christ's feet requires time, courage, humility, and a single-minded heart.

We too are invited to sit at His feet, but like Mary, it will cost us—and it will not always be easy. If you set aside an hour to wait on Him, you may feel the pull to stop early and turn to something else, something that seems "more productive." You may even be misunderstood, perhaps by those dearest to you. After all, Jesus now reigns in heaven.

If Mary was criticized for "wasting" time at His feet when He was physically present in her home, how much more might you be accused of wasting time as you wait upon Him in spirit? Yet each time you silence the noise, quiet your heart, and rest in His presence, you will find—just as Mary did—that your love for Him grows deeper, your devotion stronger, and your soul more alive.

About six months after that evening in her living room, Mary's love for Christ reached new heights. Just days before His crucifixion, she humbled herself once again and poured out an

entire jar of costly perfume upon His head and His feet. The Gospel of Mark tells us it was worth a year's wages. She did it as an act of worship, and as preparation for His burial. And how it touched the heart of Jesus! (See Mark 14:3–9; John 12:1–8)

In these two glimpses of Mary's devotion, we see a model for our own discipleship. She shows us what it means to sit at His feet: to learn from Him and worship Him.

The Lord Jesus Christ—the risen and ascended Rabbi of His Church—is still calling out to us today, "Come! Sit at My feet. I have so much to teach you."

May our hearts respond like David's: "My heart has heard you say, 'Come and talk with me.' And my heart responds, 'Lord, I am coming" (Psalm 27:8).



How to Use a Prayer Book

At The Father's House, we have gathered for prayer every Wednesday for many years. I love these times, but I've noticed some people hesitate to join. Often it's not because they don't want to pray, but because they feel unsure—uncertain of what to say or how to begin. That's natural. None of us are born knowing how to pray. Prayer is something we learn.

The disciples of Jesus needed to learn too. One day, after watching Him pray, they asked for a lesson, "Lord, teach us to pray." Jesus responded by saying:

"When you pray, say: Father, hallowed be your name. Your kingdom come. Give us each day our daily bread, and forgive us our sins, for we ourselves forgive everyone who is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation" (Luke 11:2–4).

How To Use A Prayer Book

Notice—Jesus gave them a prayer to pray. A simple track to guide them into God's presence. This practice was not unusual for Jesus. Praying written prayers was central to the Jewish faith and deeply rooted in Scripture itself. The book of Psalms is essentially a collection of prayers.

The New Testament letters also contain written prayers which taught the early Jesus followers how to pray. And, throughout church history, Christians in every era, all around the world, have continued this tradition—recording their prayers so future generations could learn to pray. From the early church fathers to the reformers and revivalists, written prayers have been used to mature the church in faith and devotion.

This little book is our attempt to carry on that tradition. As a praying community, we want to pass on what we have learned. If you've never used a prayer book before, let me offer a simple four-step guide:

1. Still yourself in God's presence.

For me, that happens most naturally in a recliner with a fresh cup of coffee. Others prefer lighting a candle, sitting in silence, or walking in nature. However you do it, this step is essential. Half the battle of prayer is learning to stop the rush of life so your body, soul, and spirit can focus on God.

How To Use A Prayer Book

2. Read the prayers slowly, out loud.

A devotional book is meant to make you *think* about God. A prayer book is meant to help you *talk* to Him. Speaking the words aloud shifts the experience. These prayers are ready to be offered as they are—no rewording required.

3. Offer them directly to the Lord.

When I was a child, my mom would often slip a dollar into my hand so I could place it into the offering plate at church. She provided the gift, but she wanted me to experience the joy of giving it to God. A prayer book works similarly. These prayers are being handed to you so that you can in turn offer them to the Lord.

4. Linger with words that stir your heart.

As you pray, take note of the words and phrases that move you—those that make your heart leap, bring a tear to your eye, or give you pause. When that happens, stop. Repeat them. Close your eyes and let them sink in. In those moments, the prayer becomes more than words—it becomes a seed that is taking root deep within your soul.

How To Use A Prayer Book

Our hope is that these pages help you discover (or rediscover) the joy of prayer. May the Spirit use them to draw you closer to Jesus, renew your prayers with fresh life, and lead you into the fullness of joy that David spoke of in Psalms 16:11: "In your presence there is fullness of joy; at your right hand are pleasures forevermore."

APPENDIX I: Pray Like An Apostle

The Apostle John wrote in 1 John 5:14: "This is the confidence that we have toward Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us."

One of the first challenges we encounter in prayer is learning how to align our hearts with God's will. Thankfully, we're not left to figure this out on our own. The Holy Spirit helps us in our weakness, interceding before the Father with groanings too deep for words (Romans 8:26–27).

Another way the Spirit helps to pray is in the way that he inspired the apostles to record many of their prayers in the New Testament for our encouragement and growth. These written prayers serve as guideposts, showing us how to pray in full harmony with God's heart. Because they were

breathed out by the Spirit, we can trust that each one perfectly reflects His will. What a priceless gift!

In this appendix, you'll find eleven of these prayers, each slightly adapted for personal use. Some pronouns have been replaced with blanks so you can easily insert the names of those you're praying for. As you do, you can intercede with bold confidence, knowing you're asking for the very things God Himself delights to give.

The ministry of intercession is a precious gift from the Lord. It's more than just praying for others—it's joining in agreement with Jesus himself, who lives forever to intercede for us (Hebrews 7:25). Intercession is one of the greatest joys in prayer, for it is a direct partnership with Christ in bringing the Father's will to pass in the lives of others.

Here's a simple way to begin: after your personal time of prayer, pause and ask the Father, "Who do you want me to pray for today?" He may place on your heart a friend, family member, coworker, leader, or even someone from your past. Whoever he brings to mind, choose one or two of the apostolic prayers and intercede for them by name.

If you feel led, consider letting the person know how you prayed for them. A simple message such as, "I prayed this Scripture over you today," can be an incredible encouragement and might touch their heart in ways you cannot imagine.

May the apostles' prayers come alive in your own life, bringing God's blessing, strength, and presence to you and those you pray for.
