The October communion offering will support Nick DeVusser, the campus minister for RUF at the University of Iowa. Here is his description of RUF: "Reformed University Fellowship (RUF) is the campus ministry of the PCA.... RUF gives a taste of the local church in hopes of getting students involved in the local church.... We accomplish this via 3 different avenues of ministry: one-on-one's, small groups, and large group. One-on-one's are opportunities for discipleship, pastoral counseling, life coaching, etc. and are generally done over a meal or cup of coffee. Small groups are generally Bible studies, prayer groups, or book studies.... Large group is a weekly worship service, usually featuring some hymns, a few liturgical elements, and a sermon. These three avenues make up the bulk of what RUF looks like week in and week out."
