Bring on 2026! A new year, a new me... isn't that how the saying goes anyway? Well, for those of us in Christ we don't need to be made new each year. We were made new the day we submitted ourselves to Christ as Lord. We are new creatures. There is no New Year's resolution needed, but instead we are answering a sacred call. Jesus' invitation still echoes clearly: "Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men" (Matthew 4:19). Discipleship is not an optional program for a few, but the calling of every believer. This year, as a church we need to commit to growing as devoted followers of Christ—learning His Word, living His truth, and loving others as He has loved us.

Discipleship begins with abiding in Christ. Jesus reminds us, "Abide in me, and I in you... whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit" (John 15:4–5). True spiritual growth does not come from striving in our own strength, but from daily dependence on Him. As a church family, we will encourage one another toward consistent prayer, faithful Scripture reading, and a life shaped by the gospel. These ordinary, often quiet disciplines are how God produces lasting fruit.

The Word of God will be central in this year of discipleship. Scripture tells us, "All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness" (2 Timothy 3:16). As we gather in worship, small groups, and personal study, we don't just seek knowledge, but transformation. God's Word renews our minds, anchors our hearts, and equips us for every good work. A disciplined church is a church rooted deeply in the truth of God's revelation.

Discipleship also flourishes in community. We were never meant to follow Christ alone. The early church provides a beautiful picture: "They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers" (Acts 2:42). This year, we aim to strengthen relationships across generations—bearing one another's burdens, speaking truth in love, and stirring one another up to good works (Hebrews 10:24–25). God will shape this Bible first community of Christians through encouragement, accountability, and shared joy.

Finally, discipleship sends us outward on mission. Jesus' command remains our mission: "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations" (Matthew 28:19). As we grow in Christ, we are also called to reflect Him in our homes, workplaces, schools, and neighborhoods. A disciplined life is a witnessing life—marked by humility, service, and a bold hope in the gospel.

As we enter this new year together, let's commit ourselves to walking faithfully with one another in Christ Jesus. May the Lord use this season to deepen our faith, strengthen our love, and multiply disciples for His glory. "And I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ" (Philippians 1:6).

May God bless you, brothers and sisters, the new year, and all the work done for the glory of His kingdom!

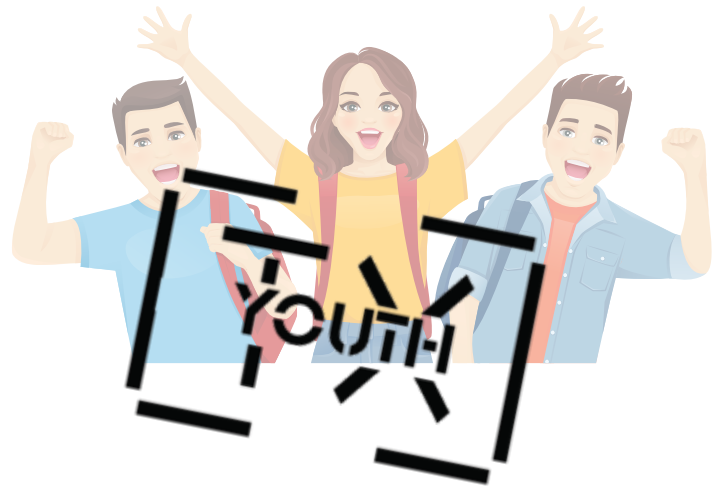
CHRISTMAS IN THE ARENA

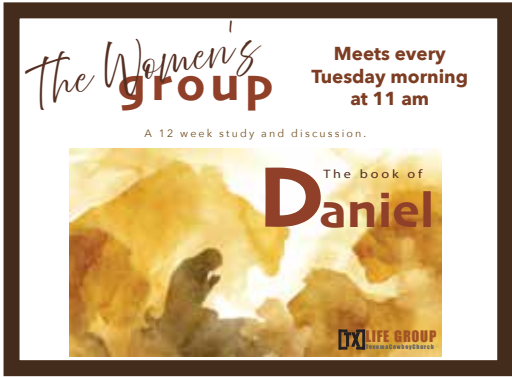


Youth Ride Tuesday nights from 6:00 pm - 8:00 pm. Horseback riding lessons for all ages.

Adult rides 6:00 - 8:00 pm on the first Tuesday of the month.

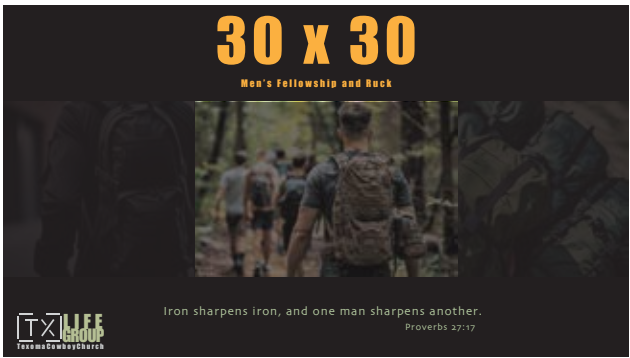
Don't have a horse of your own? Not a problem. We will provide you with a horse to ride.

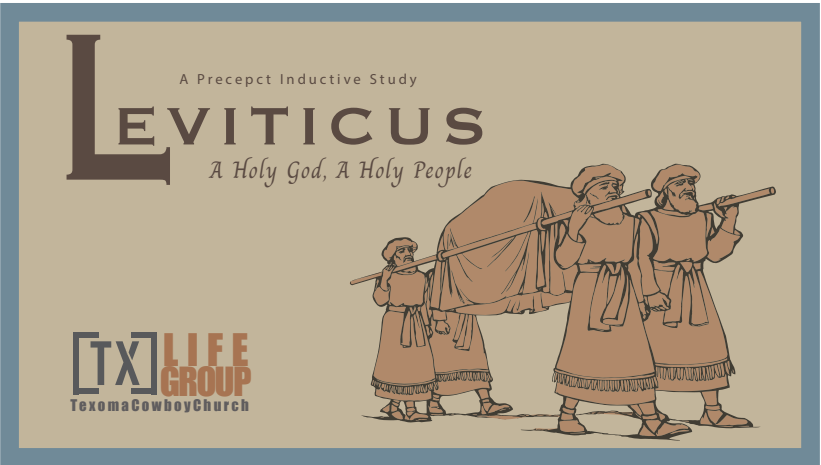

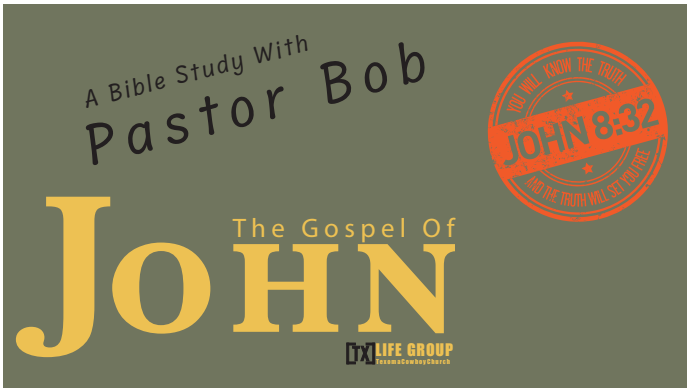
