### The Right Way to Settle a Fight: How to Biblically settle grievances and disputes among Christians

*"I say this to your shame. Can it be that there is no one among you wise enough to settle a dispute between the brothers, but brother goes to law against brother, and that before unbelievers? To have lawsuits at all with one another is already a defeat for you. Why not rather suffer wrong? Why not rather be defrauded? But you yourselves wrong and defraud—even your own brothers!" (1 Corinthians 6:5-8)*

  - A. 1 Corinthians 6:2-3
  - B. If Christians are to the world and judge the angels, surely we are competent to settle disputes and wrongdoings within the community of faith.
  - C. Our ministry is of reconciliation. Reconciliation among brothers and sisters in Christ happens through genuine repentance and forgiveness.
