Our mission is not simply to attend but to follow—to be disciples who make disciples. Jesus commanded, “Go therefore and make disciples of all nations... teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you” (Matthew 28:19–20). This means our groups, events, and ministries must serve as pathways to deeper discipleship and opportunities to share the good news of salvation.

Let us keep Christ at the center. Let every fellowship group, every study, every gathering point to the cross, to the hope of salvation, and to the call to grow as faithful followers of Jesus.

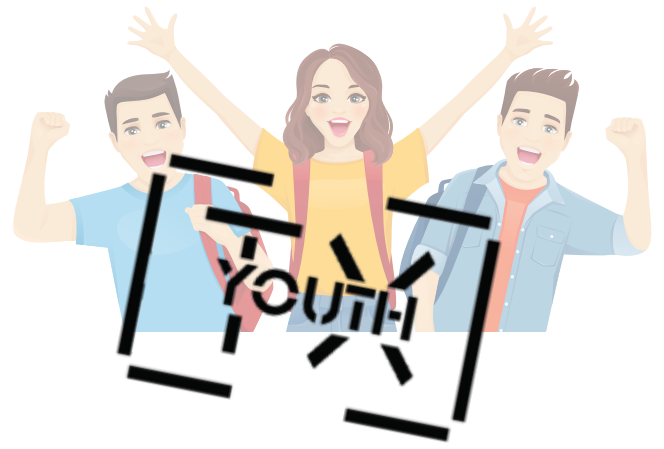

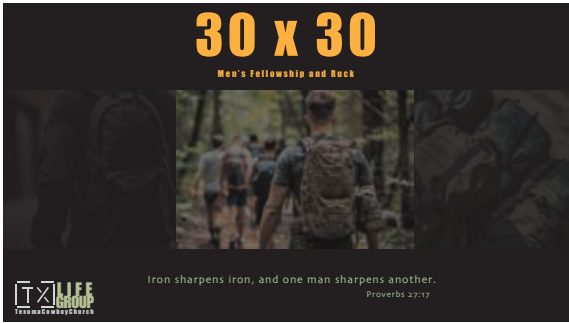


Youth Ride Tuesday nights from 6:00 pm - 8:00 pm. Horseback riding lessons for all ages.

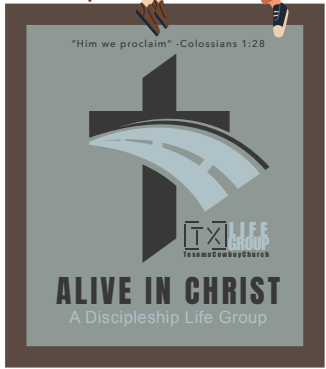
Adult rides 6:00 - 8:00 pm on the first Tuesday of the month.

Ruck/Walk 30 min out 30 min back taking in God's creation and glory. Keeping his temple he blessed us with spiritually and physically fit.

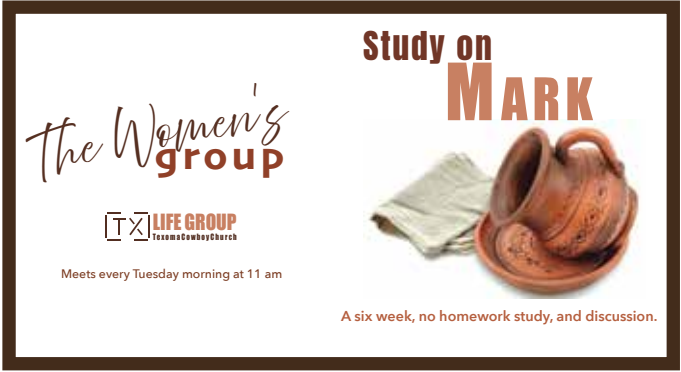


This is a discipleship life group and we currently looking into the Acts of the Apostles.

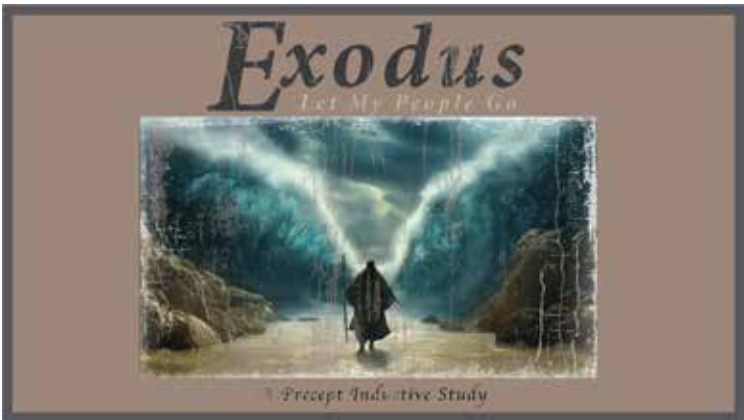
