IT'S TIME FOR YOU TO DREAM AGAIN

VISION: WHAT DO YOU SEE?

One of Rachel and I's favorite rhythms at the start of every year is taking intentional time to reflect on where we've been—and dream with God about what's ahead. It's a chance to pause, to look honestly at the last twelve months, and to ask, "What went well? What needs to change? And who is God shaping us into this year?"

We talk about everything—from our physical health to our spiritual life, from daily habits to the big dreams tugging on our hearts. And every year, we walk away surprised by the ideas, clarity, and excitement God brings when we make space to listen.

There's something sacred about a new year. Everyone loves fresh starts—those moments where you feel permission to reset, re-center, and step back into the things that matter most. So let's talk about dreaming and having vision.

Does God care about our dreams? Scripture shows us He absolutely does. From Genesis to Revelation, we see a God who imagines restoration—and then invites His people to partner with Him in bringing it to life.

We are invited to participate in the redemptive work of taking chaos and cultivating thriving. You can't do that without being willing to imagine a better world—within your own heart, within your home, and beyond your walls.

Having vision isn't about trying to manufacture a future on our own. It's simply paying attention to what God has already placed in your life: your story, your passions, your gifts, your people—your life. It's asking, "What would it look like to honor God with what He's already given me?" It's not complicated. It's intentional.

Pray & Listen. Reflect & Dream. See & Plan. Commit.
You have a future. You have a Hope. It's life following
Jesus : full, free, and overflowing with purpose.

Explore four main areas of your life:

**1. Spiritual 2. Relational 3. Personal + Health 4. Work +
Calling**

Our hope is that these tools help you grow, think differently, and stretch your faith. We want you to dream bigger with God—to step out of the patterns that keep you stuck and into the life He's inviting you to live. Be transformed.

The first step is to bring your desires to God. Have you prayed about "it" yet? We all can need to be reminded from time to time what God tells us:

"Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God..." Philippians 4:6-7

God tells us exactly what to do: Bring our desires to Him. Lay out what we long for. Speak it out loud. Trust Him with it.

This doesn't mean we always get what we want. We all know that. But something holy happens when we bring our desires honestly before God—we build relationship. We move from gripping and controlling to trusting and surrendering. Jesus models this perfectly in Gethsemane. He prays, "Take this cup from me," and then surrenders, "Yet not my will, but

yours." He knows the weight of longing, disappointment, and grief. And He knows the trust required to say, "Father, my life is yours."

Before you start this guide, pray. Take time to tell God all of your thoughts from the year and ask Him how He sees the past year of your life and what He is calling you to become and do in 2026.

As we step into a new year, our prayer for you is this:

That you would courageously dream with God.

That you would reflect honestly.

That you would bring your desires to Him with open hands.

And that you would keep taking your next faithful step as you authentically follow Jesus.
