Leaders,

We've all been there. You've asked a question and anticipate an immediate response from the group and... it's crickets. PANIC! Or, we've over-anticipated and asked a question and then immediately answered it ourselves leaving no room for anyone else. Believe it or not, there is purpose and growth that can happen in the silence. It's OK for there to be moments of quiet - no need to panic! Members may need some time to really digest the question or to give hard thought to how or if they respond. Purposeful pause on your part as a leader can be a great way to allow all members the chance to participate and even encourage those who might not talk much to have a voice. As leaders we often feel the pull of having to lead the conversation when in fact, allowing the space for your members to answer freely will encourage the conversation to flow to a place you might

have never imagined! The heart of Community Groups are relationships and those are formed through the sharing of everyone in the group. As leaders, be sure to use the pause when the time is right and not shy away from it! Give it a try the next few weeks and see how the group responds.

Groups Ministry Needs

We Need Group Leaders in the Show Low and Pinetop area. Ideally those Groups are willing to include FAMILIES with CHILDREN! (Do I sound like a broken record yet?) As Group Leaders you have an opportunity to empower future leaders, to walk alongside them and partner with the CHURCH to show Godlike hospitality in your homes and communities. This means stepping outside of your comfort zone and multiplying Community

Groups. Not sure where to start? Let's talk. Enrolling in our New Apprenticeship Program for 2025 is a great start!

- Your Part: The goal for each of you this year is to raise up 1 (minimum) new Community Group Apprentice. Encourage a culture of multiplication within your groups. Allow members to lead with support, be active participants within the group and step into a position of ownership and accountability within the group. If every group can produce 1 new leader in 2023, we will have 42 Community Groups by this time next year, doubling our current capacity.
- Waiting List: We have a family with children in Lakeside and ANOTHER in Show Low with children that are waiting for a group. If you can facilitate either of these families, please let me know.

Real Numbers & Real People:

- Current Participation in the last 6 months:
 - 21 Community Groups: 223 people engaged
 - 4 Women's Groups: 63 people engaged
 - 4 Men's Group: 50 people engaged
 - 1 Singles Group: 12 people engaged
 - 1 20 Somethings Group: 15 people engaged
 - 1 GriefShare Group: 20 People engaged
 - Group Leaders: 60

I share these numbers each month to not only share our growth, but for you to see that you are a part of something bigger than your weekly group.

Together we are sharing Jesus with hundreds of people all over this mountain - and we are just getting started!
